


#### **Overview:**

The eight crime indicators statistic for April, 2023 revealed an increase of 1% from the March, 2023 datum, however was 19% higher than the five year average for April of 63 reported occurrences.


The predominance of this increase in April, 2023 is seen in the category of theft, which registered an increase of 41% (or 12 reported occurrences) from the March, 2023 statistic.


A further analysis of this category revealed increases in other theft under \$5,000 (6), thefts from motor vehicle (3) and shoplifting (3). In 50% or half of the reported other theft under \$5,000 occurrences, the victim and suspect are known to each other. In 70% of the theft from motor vehicle occurrences, it was determined that the vehicle was unlocked when the theft occurred.

# **April 2023 Eight Crime Indicators Map**




# Occurrence Zones Break & Enter and Thefts – April 2023






#### April 2020, 2021, 2022 & 2023 Break & Enter and Thefts

# "Mandatory Alcohol Screening" (MAS) Statistics



There were no charges under the Alberta Zero Alcohol Tolerance (AZAT) for graduated drivers, and no 24 hour suspensions issued. There were also no impaired by alcohol or drug occurrences.

During the month of April, 2023 there were no Standard Field Sobriety Tests (SFST) or Drug Recognition Evaluation Tests (DRE) conducted.


#### Crimes Against Persons

The total number of Crimes against Persons was 17 in April of 2023, compared to 39 in April of 2022, 13 in April of 2021 and 21 in April of 2020.


# Crimes Against Property 5 Year Monthly Average – 63

# Drug Occurrences


5 Year Monthly Average – 4










