Statistics gathered for this report are based on the best available information at the time of drafting, and could be subject to change based on files being under investigation, or being reported at a later date.





Overview:




Slight increases were noted in the categories of theft of motor vehicle, sexual assault & robbery.

August 2023 Eight Crime Indicators Map




Occurrence Zones Break & Enter and Thefts – August 2023






August 2020, 2021, 2022 & 2023 Break & Enter and Thefts

"Mandatory Alcohol Screening" (MAS) Statistics


In the month of August, 2023, nine hundred & seventy-three (973) MAS tests were conducted, which resulted in twenty-five (25) charges being laid under the Intermediate Roadside Suspensions (IRS). There were no charges under the Alberta Zero Alcohol Tolerance (AZAT) for graduated drivers, and two (2) 24-hour suspensions issued. There was also one (1) impaired by alcohol or drug occurrence.

Crimes Against Persons


5 Year Monthly Average – 33

Crimes Against Property


5 Year Monthly Average – 90

Drug Occurrences


5 Year Monthly Average – 4








