Statistics gathered for this report are based on the best available information at the time of drafting, and could be subject to change based on files being under investigation, or being reported at a later date.





#### **Overview:**


The statistic for the eight crime indicators in December, 2023, recorded a 31% decrease from the November, 2023 statistic (or 27 reported occurrences), and is in line with the five-year average for December of 58 reported occurrences.


A pronounced increase is pointed out in the category of homicide, where as a result of one occurrence, five counts of attempted murder were laid during a familial dispute where the accused set fire to a mobile home.

# December 2023 Eight Crime Indicators Map




# Occurrence Zones Break & Enter and Thefts – December 2023






#### December 2020, 2021, 2022 & 2023 Break & Enter and Thefts

## "Mandatory Alcohol Screening" (MAS) Statistics



# Crimes Against Persons


5 Year Monthly Average – 20

# Crimes Against Property


5 Year Monthly Average – 58

## Drug Occurrences


5 Year Monthly Average – 5






