Statistics gathered for this report are based on the best available information at the time of drafting, and could be subject to change based on files being under investigation, or being reported at a later date.



January 73 February 45


Overview:

The February, 2023 statistic for the eight crime indicators recorded a pronounced decrease of 38% from the January, 2023 total or 28 reported occurrences.


The only category to record a statistical increase from January, 2023 to February, 2023 was Assault, which saw an expansion of 4 reported occurrences. An analysis of this category revealed 4 out of 6 occurrences involved intimate partner or familial violence, including repeat subjects in 3 of the occurrences. Further, in 1 occurrence the suspect and victim were known to each other, in another occurrence the suspect and victim were unknown to each other, and 2 occurrences involved assaults on Police. Intoxication was a known contributing factor in 4 of the 10 occurrences.


The remaining eight crime indicators categories recorded a decrease and were all below or equal to the 5 year monthly average for February.

February 2023 Eight Crime Indicators Map




Occurrence Zones Break & Enter and Thefts – February 2023






February 2020, 2021, 2022 & 2023 Break & Enter and Thefts

"Mandatory Alcohol Screening" (MAS) Statistics


In the month of February, 2023, 108 MAS tests were conducted, which resulted in six charges being laid under the Intermediate Roadside Suspensions (IRS). There were no charges under the Alberta Zero Alcohol Tolerance (AZAT) for graduated drivers, and one 24 hour suspension was issued. There were also no impaired by alcohol or drug occurrences.

Crimes Against Property


5 Year Monthly Average – 56










