Statistics gathered for this report are based on the best available information at the time of drafting, and could be subject to change based on files being under investigation, or being reported at a later date.



Overview:


In January, 2023, the eight crime indicators recorded a 3% increase from the December, 2022 statistic of 71 reported occurrences.

Increases were noted in all categories excluding mischief, assault and homicide.


Increases in the category of break & enter are contributed to a series of four (4) garage break in's which occurred the same night and it is believed an adult male suspect is responsible for all occurrences. Further increases can be attributed to two (2) garage break & enters where unlocked detached garages were entered and a vehicle was stolen in each of the occurrences.


The category of sexual assault also recorded an increase as a result of two (2) historic occurrences being reported, along with two (2) reported occurrences where the victim's declined to provide a statement of have an investigation conducted.

January 2023 Eight Crime Indicators Map




Occurrence Zones Break & Enter and Thefts – January 2023






January 2020, 2021, 2022 & 2023 Break & Enter and Thefts

"Mandatory Alcohol Screening" (MAS) Statistics



Crimes Against Property


5 Year Monthly Average – 64

Drug Occurrences


5 Year Monthly Average – 13










