Statistics gathered for this report are based on the best available information at the time of drafting, and could be subject to change based on files being under investigation, or being reported at a later date.





Overview:


The July 2023 statistic for the total eight crime indicators recorded an increase of 27% (or 21 reported occurrences) from the June, 2023 total.


A noticeable increase was seen in the category of assault, which recorded an increase of 18 reported occurrences. An analysis of this category revealed that twelve (12) of the twenty-two (22) reported occurrences involved domestic or familial violence. Seven (7) of familial violence occurrences involved parents who were assaulted by their sons, and two (2) of the charged subjects were involved in repeat occurrences in July, 2023.

July 2023 Eight Crime Indicators Map




Occurrence Zones Break & Enter and Thefts – July 2023






July 2020, 2021, 2022 & 2023 Break & Enter and Thefts

"Mandatory Alcohol Screening" (MAS) Statistics



Crimes Against Persons


5 Year Monthly Average – 28

Crimes Against Property


5 Year Monthly Average – 63

Drug Occurrences


5 Year Monthly Average – 4










