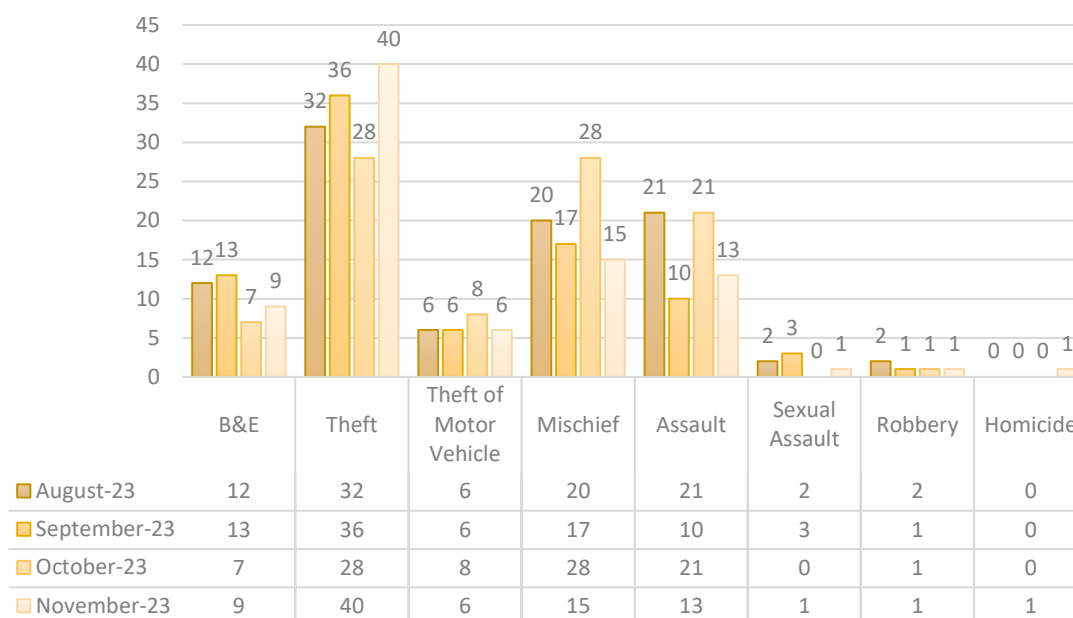

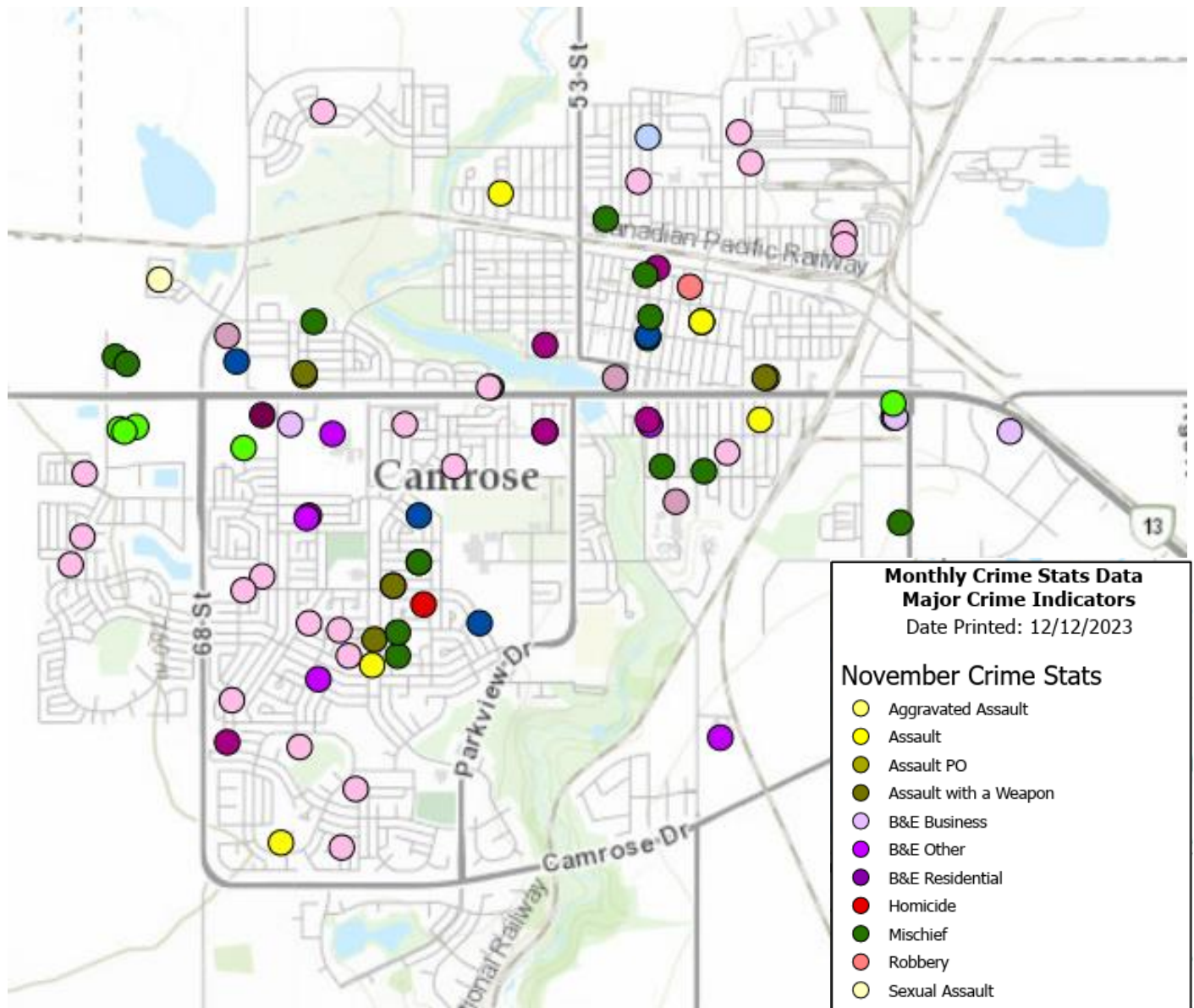
Overview:

The statistic for the November, 2023 eight crime indicators recorded a decrease of 7%, or 7 reported occurrences from the October, 2023 statistic.

Despite this decrease, a significant increase of reported occurrences was observed in the category of theft, which registered an increase of 43%, or 12 reported occurrences. A review of this category determined that the 4-year monthly average for theft from motor vehicle is 3 reported occurrences, however November, 2023 recorded 23 reported occurrences. Further analysis identified a crime trend of 16 reported occurrences of theft from motor vehicle where the vehicles were unlocked and wallets or cash was stolen. The most prevalent zone for these offences were zone C2, C3 and C4.

A further perusal of the crimes against property occurrences saw the November, 2023 total statistic double in comparison from the November, 2022 total statistic – increasing from 46 total reported occurrences in 2022, to 91 total reported occurrences in 2023. A breakdown of each category is documented on the last two pages of this report.

November 2023 Eight Crime Indicators Map



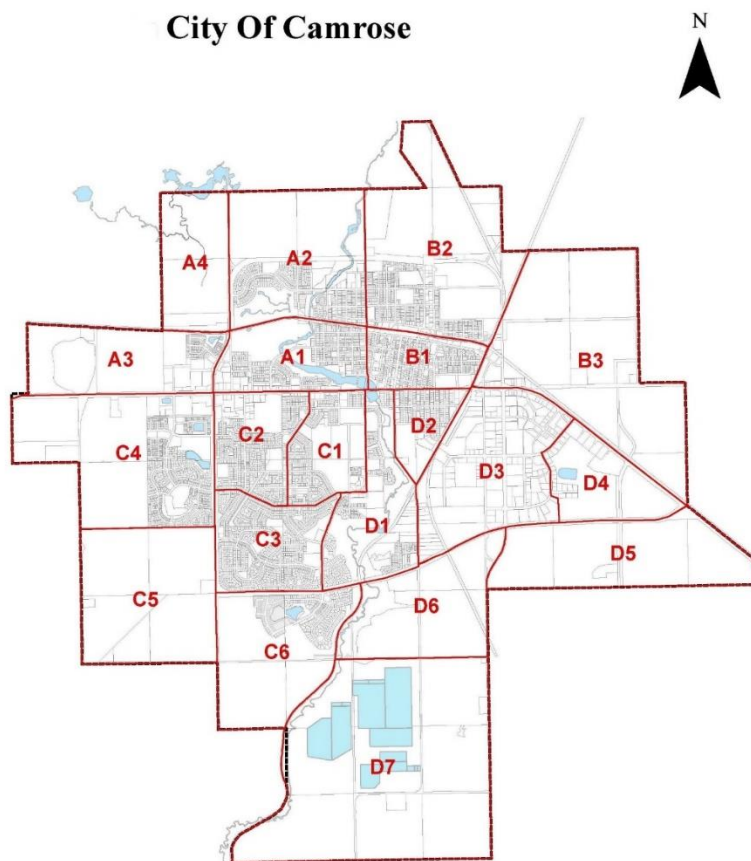
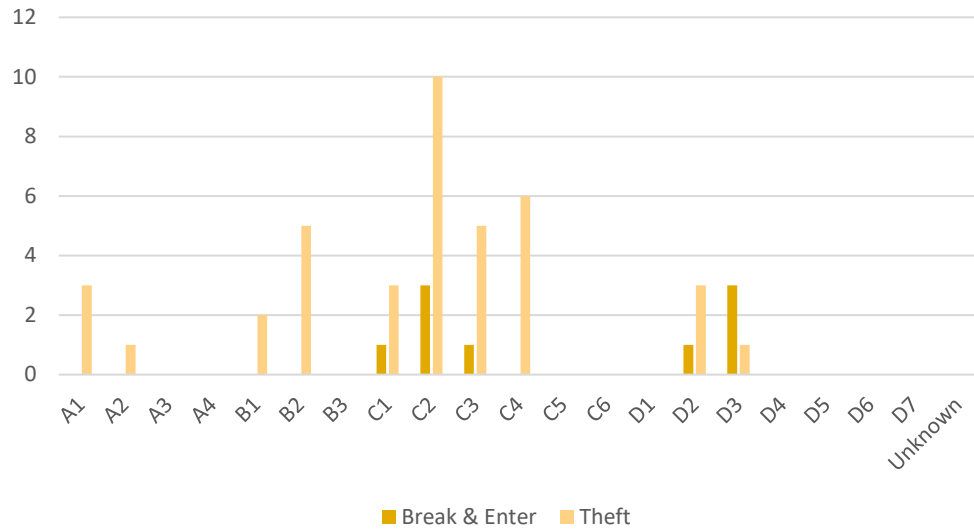

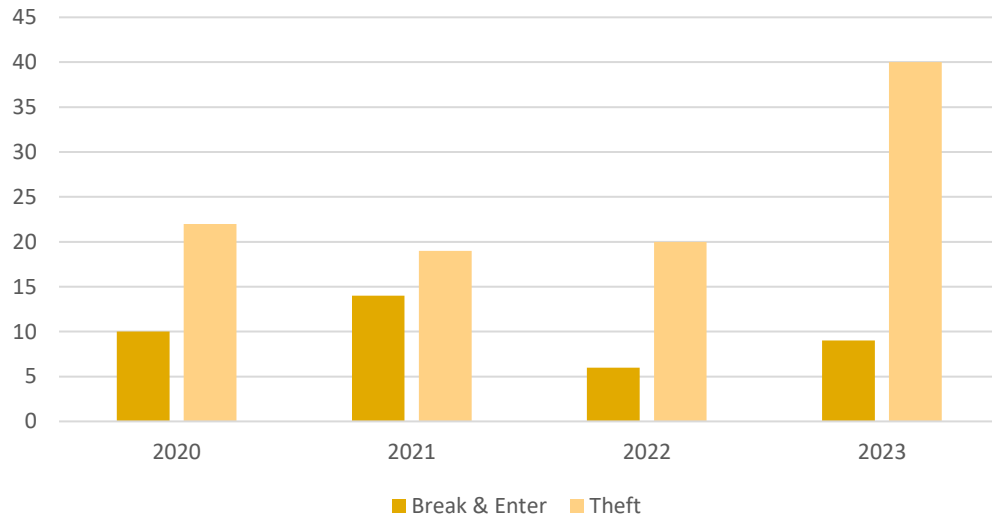

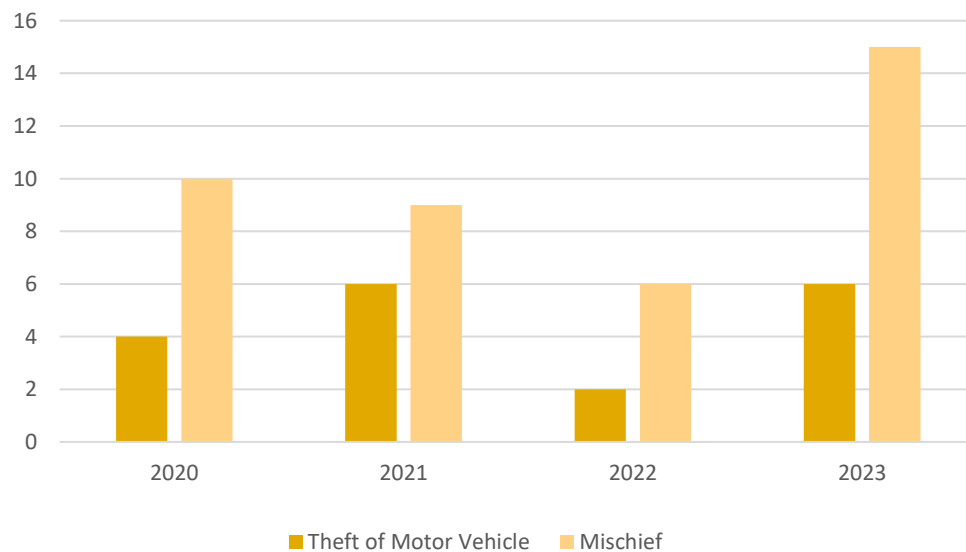

“Mandatory Alcohol Screening” (MAS) Statistics

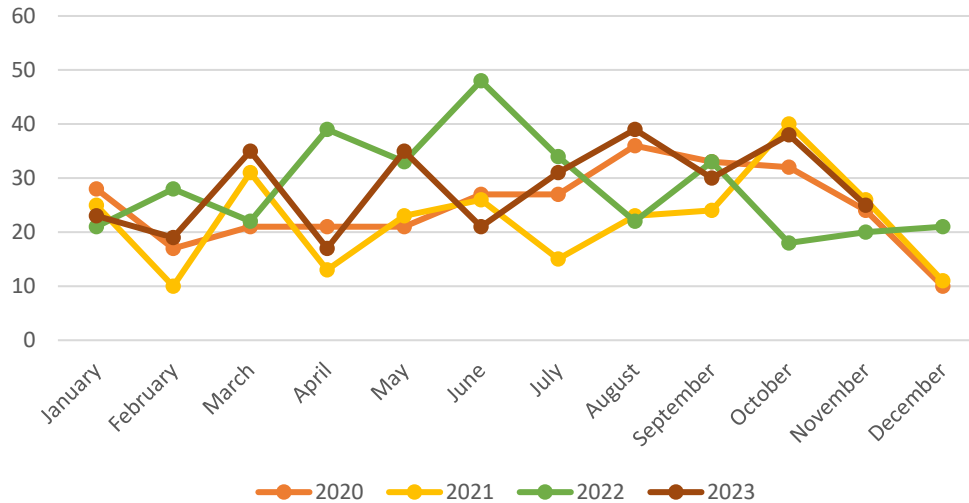
In the month of November, 2023, one hundred & fifty-three (153) MAS tests were conducted, which resulted in seven (7) charges being laid under the Intermediate Roadside Suspensions (IRS). There were no charges under the Alberta Zero Alcohol Tolerance (AZAT) for graduated drivers, and two (2) 24-hour suspensions issued. There was also no impaired by alcohol or drug occurrence.

Crimes Against Persons

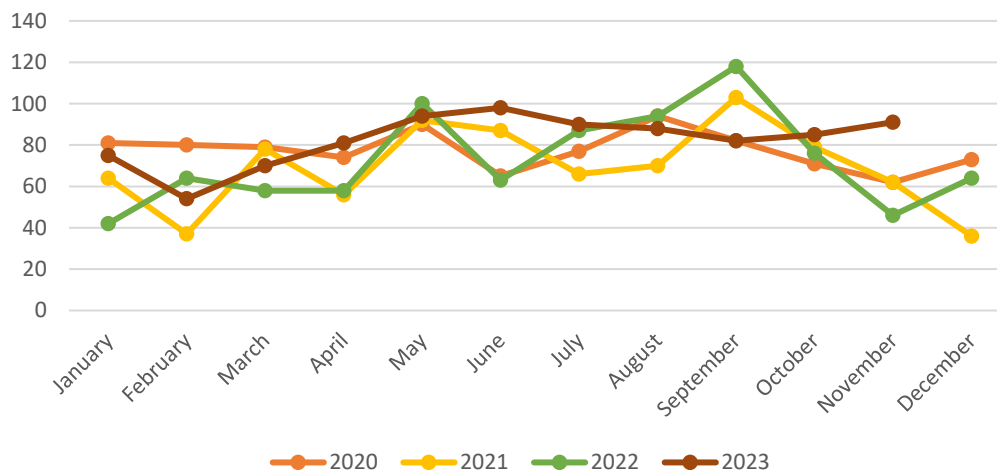
5 Year Monthly Average – 24

Crimes Against Property

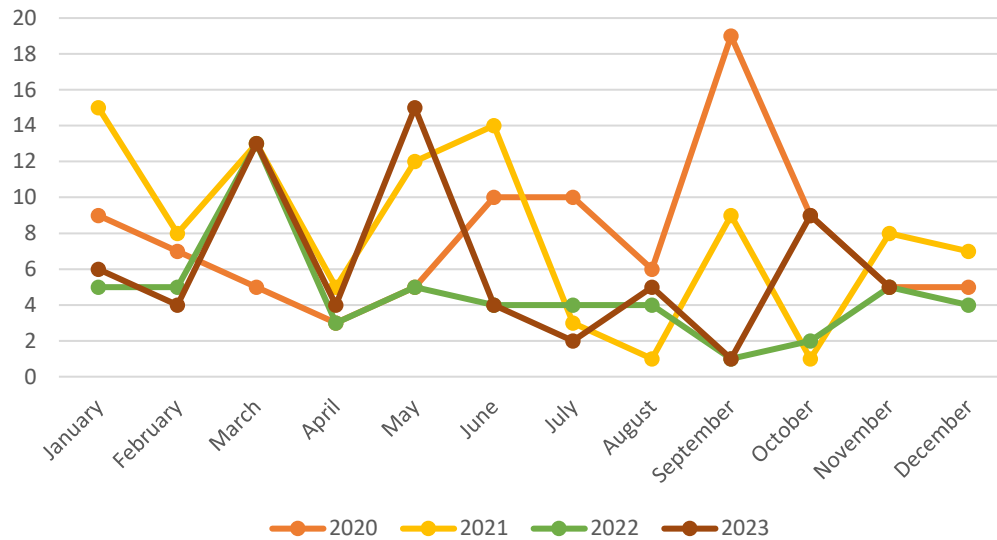
5 Year Monthly Average – 70

Drug Occurrences

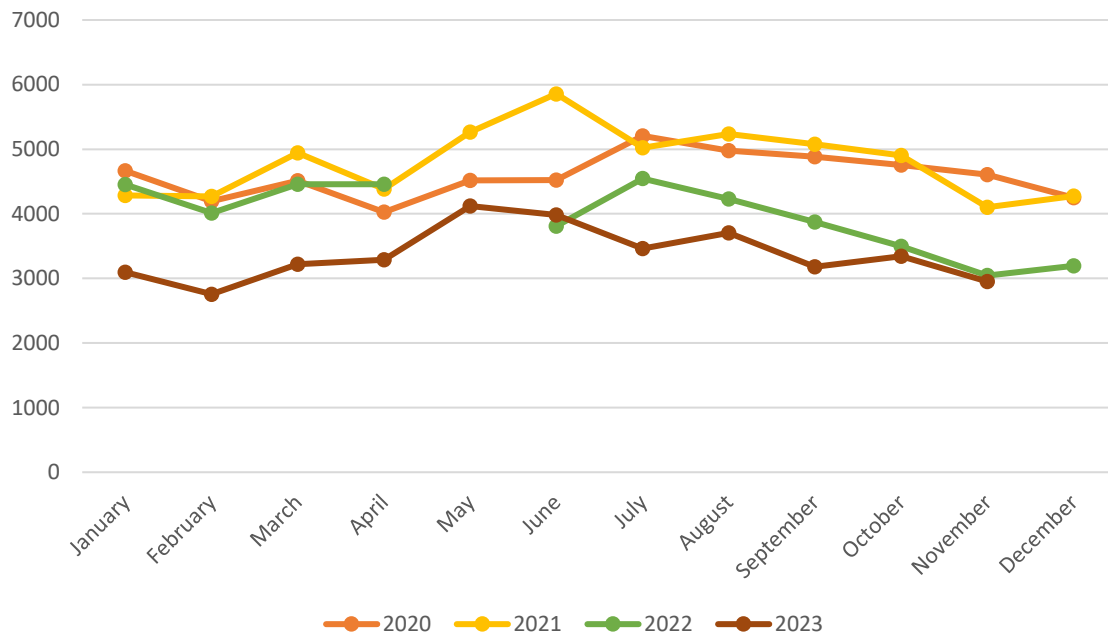
5 Year Monthly Average – 6

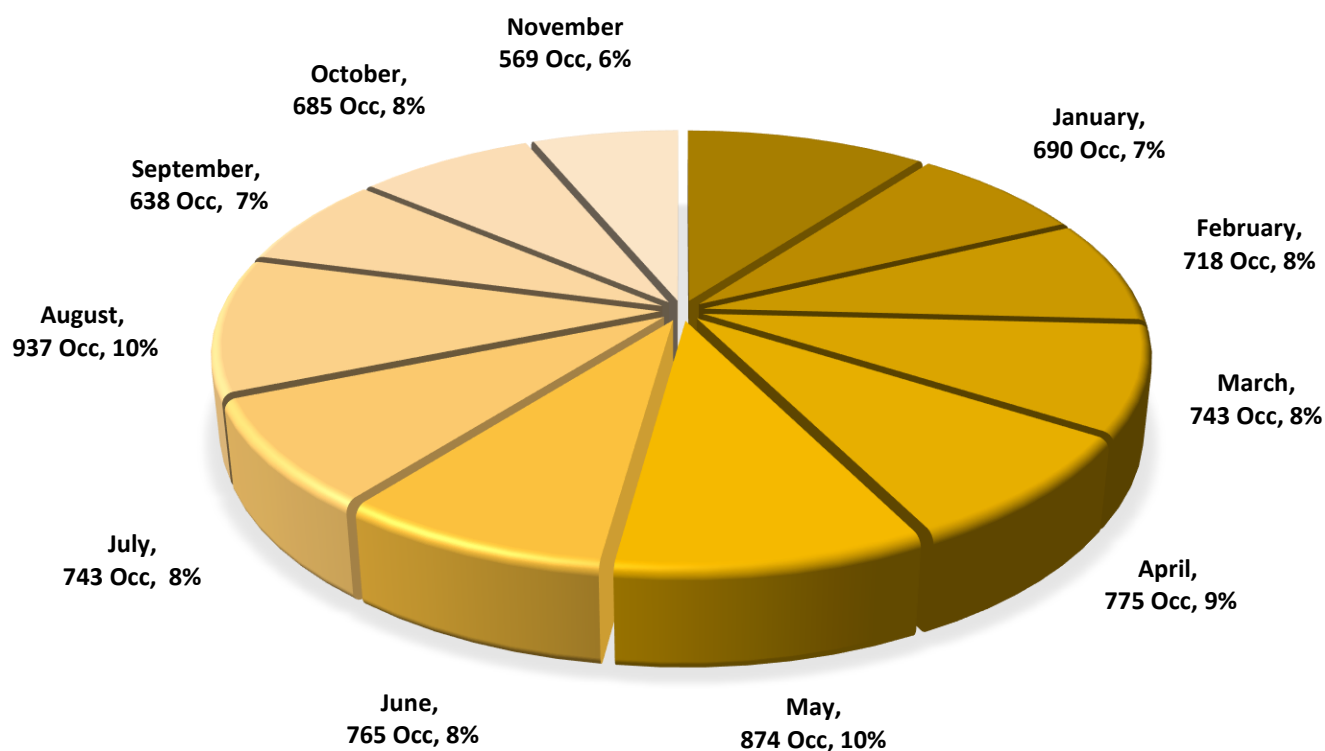

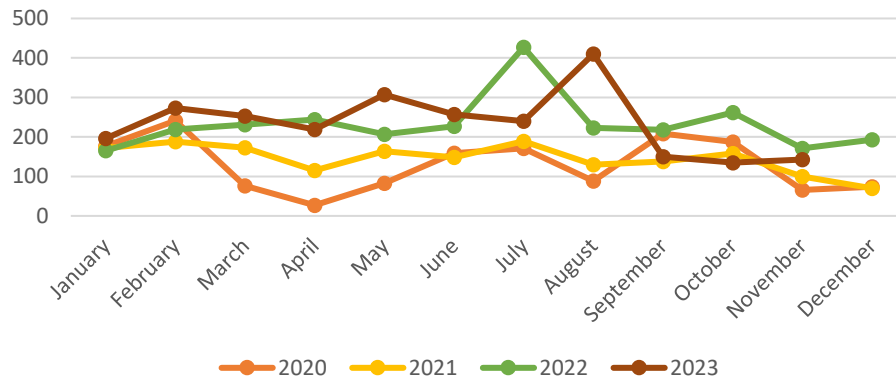

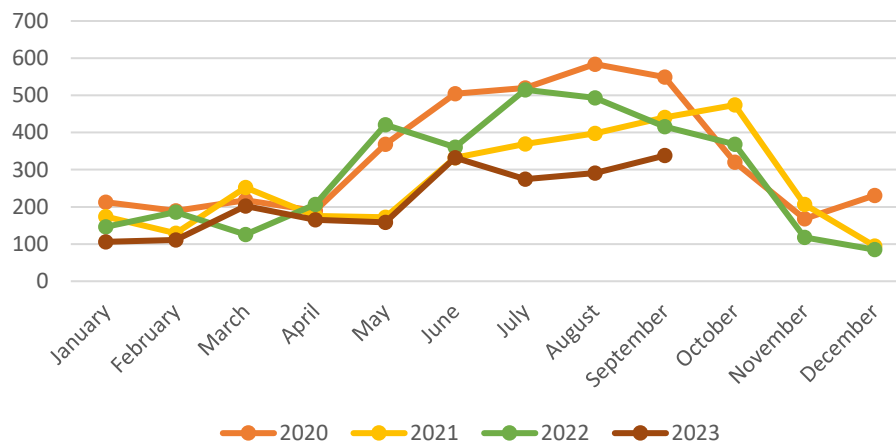

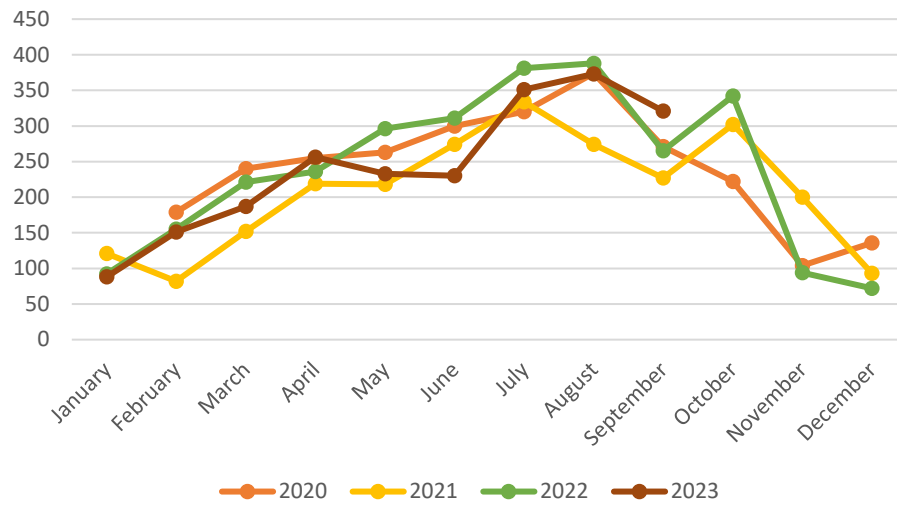
