

#### **Overview:**


The statistic for the eight crime indicators for February, 2024, increased 9% (or 6 reported occurrences) from the January, 2024 statistic, and is seventeen (17) reported occurrences above the 5-year average for February.


The majority of this increase was captured in the category of Break & Enter which rose 175 % (or 7 reported occurrences), and involved a series of three (3) break ins at a storage facility and three (3) occurrences of compounds/dealerships being entered & vehicles stolen.

# February 2024 Eight Crime Indicators Map




# Occurrence Zones Break & Enter and Thefts - February 2024






#### February 2021, 2022, 2023 & 2024 Break & Enter and Thefts

## "Mandatory Alcohol Screening" (MAS) Statistics



#### **Crimes Against Persons**


5 Year Monthly Average – 19

#### **Crimes Against Property**


5 Year Monthly Average – 63

#### **Drug Occurrences**


5 Year Monthly Average – 6








