Statistics gathered for this report are based on the best available information at the time of drafting, and could be subject to change based on files being under investigation, or being reported at a later date.




Overview:

In May, 2024, the eight crime indicators captured an increase of 32% (or 24 reported occurrences) from the April, 2024 stat; however, this data is consistent with the 5-year average for May of 93 reported occurrences.


The increase in crime was primarily attributed to a seasonal surge in theft from motor vehicles, particularly during crime spree(s) spanning from May 13 – May 30, 2024, where the majority of these thefts from motor vehicles occurred in zone C4, followed by zone C3. Two male youths have been identified and charges have been laid against them in a series of occurrences.


Overall, the crime report for May, 2024 highlights an increase in criminal activity from the previous month, but also underscores a proactive response in investigating and addressing crime.

May 2024 Eight Crime Indicators Map




Occurrence Zones Break & Enter and Thefts - May 2024






May 2021, 2022, 2023 & 2024 Break & Enter and Thefts

"Mandatory Alcohol Screening" (MAS) Statistics


In the month of May, 2024, four hundred & seventy-two (472) MAS tests were conducted, which resulted in five (5) charges being laid under the Intermediate Roadside Suspensions (IRS). There was no charges under the Alberta Zero Alcohol Tolerance (AZAT) for graduated drivers, and six (6) 24-hour suspensions issued. There was one (1) impaired by alcohol or drug occurrence.

Crimes Against Persons


5 Year Monthly Average – 28

Crimes Against Property


5 Year Monthly Average – 98

Drug Occurrences


5 Year Monthly Average – 9










