Statistics gathered for this report are based on the best available information at the time of drafting, and could be subject to change based on files being under investigation, or being reported at a later date.



Overview:


In June 2024, the overall crime statistics for our community reveal a notable decrease of 38% in reported occurrences across eight major crime indicators compared to May 2024. This reduction amounts to 38 fewer reported incidents, marking a positive trend in overall crime reduction.

Despite this general decline, one trend stands out: an increase in the category of mischief. This rise has been largely attributed to the actions of a 20-year-old male who has been charged in connection with 15 incidents involving the deliberate smashing of windows on both buildings and parked vehicles.


In addition to the aforementioned mischief incidents, a second pattern emerged involving vehicle vandalism. Two adult male siblings were apprehended and charged for their involvement in a spree of vehicle damage, further adding to the criminal activity reported during the month.


It is worth noting that despite the increase in mischief-related incidents, the overall crime rate for June 2024 remains 14% below the five-year average for the month of June.

June 2024 Eight Crime Indicators Map




Occurrence Zones Break & Enter and Thefts - June 2024






June 2021, 2022, 2023 & 2024 Break & Enter and Thefts

"Mandatory Alcohol Screening" (MAS) Statistics


In the month of June, 2024, forty-three (43) MAS tests were conducted, which resulted in eight (8) charges being laid under the Intermediate Roadside Suspensions (IRS). There was one (1) charge under the Alberta Zero Alcohol Tolerance (AZAT) for graduated drivers, and no 24-hour suspensions issued. There was also no impaired by alcohol or drug occurrences.

Crimes Against Persons


5 Year Monthly Average – 27

Crimes Against Property


5 Year Monthly Average – 76

Drug Occurrences


5 Year Monthly Average – 7










