



Overview:


Despite a significant 33% increase in the eight crime indicators from June to July, with the number of occurrences rising from 61 to 81, it's important to note that the July statistic remains below the 5-year average of 87 reported occurrences for this month. Interestingly, the current figure of 81 is equal to that of July 2020, a period when COVID-19 restrictions were in place, likely affecting crime patterns.


While the rise from June is concerning, the overall level of reported crime is still within the typical range observed in recent years. This suggests that while there has been a recent spike, particularly in categories like assault, break and enter, and theft, the broader trend may not yet indicate a sustained or alarming increase in criminal activity beyond historical norms.

July 2024 Eight Crime Indicators Map




Occurrence Zones Break & Enter and Thefts - July 2024






July 2021, 2022, 2023 & 2024 Break & Enter and Thefts

"Mandatory Alcohol Screening" (MAS) Statistics



Crimes Against Persons


5 Year Monthly Average – 27

Crimes Against Property


5 Year Monthly Average – 79

Drug Occurrences


5 Year Monthly Average – 4










