


Crime Statistics Report Summary:

In January 2025, the overall statistics for the eight crime indicators showed a 12% decline from December 2024 (a decrease of 6 incidents) and were 23% below the 5-year average for January.


The only category to experience an increase was Assault, which saw 1 additional reported incident.

A closer look at this category revealed that 7 out of the 8 reported assaults were related to intimate partner violence. Additionally, two of the reports referred to the same incident, where each person involved reported the occurrence separately at different times.


January 2025 Eight Crime Indicators Map




Eight Crime Indicators Heat Map




Occurrence Zones Break & Enter and Thefts January 2025






January 2022, 2023, 2024 & 2025 Break & Enter and Thefts




January 2022, 2023, 2024 & 2025 Theft of Motor Vehicle & Mischiefs

"Mandatory Alcohol Screening" (MAS) Statistics


In January 2025, a total of 180 Mandatory Alcohol Screening (MAS) tests were administered, resulting in 2 charges being laid under the Intermediate Roadside Suspensions (IRS) program. There were no charges related to the Alberta Zero Alcohol Tolerance (AZAT) for graduated drivers, and 2 individuals received 24-hour suspensions. Notably, there were no reported incidents of impaired driving due to alcohol or drugs during the month.

Drug Impaired Driving Tests

During the month of January, 2025 there were 2 Standard Field Sobriety Tests (SFST) and 1 Drug Recognition Evaluation Test (DRE) performed.

Crimes Against Persons


5 Year Monthly Average – 22

Crimes Against Property


5 Year Monthly Average – 60

Drug Occurrences


5 Year Monthly Average – 7










