

Crime Statistics Report Summary:


The combined total of the eight crime indicators showed a seasonal increase of 32% in May 2025, with 23 additional reported incidents compared to April. Despite this rise, the total of 92 occurrences remains slightly below the five-year average of 95 for the month of May.

In May 2025, the Break & Enter category doubled compared to April. A review revealed a crime pattern between May 12–19, during which four garage doors were left open overnight, leading to the theft of tools, copper wire and a bicycle. Additionally, in four of the reported occurrences, the suspect was known to the victim and entered the home to retrieve what they claimed was their own property. Notably, three Break & Enter incidents also involved the theft of a motor vehicle, which contributed to the increase in the Theft of Motor Vehicle category.


Mischief incidents also rose in May, with two of the reports directly linked to Break & Enter occurrences.

The Assault category experienced an increase as well. A closer review found that nine incidents involved familial or intimate partner violence, including four incidents involving one family and two incidents involving another, highlighting recurring familial conflict as a significant factor in these statistics.


May 2025 Eight Crime Indicators Map




Eight Crime Indicators Heat Map – May 2025




Eight Crime Indicators Heat Map for 1st Quarter January – March, 2025




Occurrence Zones Break & Enter and Thefts May 2025






May 2022, 2023, 2024 & 2025 Break & Enter and Thefts

"Mandatory Alcohol Screening" (MAS) Statistics


In May 2025, a total of forty-seven Mandatory Alcohol Screening (MAS) tests were administered, resulting in five charges being laid under the Intermediate Roadside Suspensions (IRS) program. There were no charges related to the Alberta Zero Alcohol Tolerance (AZAT) for graduated drivers, and one 24-hour suspension issued. There were also no impaired by alcohol or drug occurrences during the month.

Drug Impaired Driving Tests

During the month of May 2025 there was one Standard Field Sobriety Tests (SFST) and one Drug Recognition Evaluation Test (DRE) performed.

Crimes Against Persons


5 Year Monthly Average – 29

Crimes Against Property


5 Year Monthly Average – 97

Drug Occurrences


5 Year Monthly Average – 10










