

Number of Occurrences for these 8 Crime Types




Crime Statistics Report Summary:


In June 2025, the total number of reported incidents across the eight crime indicators increased by five compared to May 2025. More significantly, the total was 29% higher—22 additional occurrences—than the five-year average for the month of June.

The most notable increase was in the theft category, which rose by 17 incidents. Further analysis identified a substantial portion of these as shoplifting cases, primarily involving a group of travelling offenders linked to similar incidents in Red Deer, Lacombe, Leduc and Camrose. In another case, two individuals arrested for shoplifting were found to be responsible for thefts at five local businesses. Additionally, five of the 18 reported shoplifting incidents occurred at a liquor store.


June 2025 Eight Crime Indicators Map



Eight Crime Indicators Heat Map – June 2025




Eight Crime Indicators Heat Map for 2nd Quarter April - June, 2025




Occurrence Zones Break & Enter and Thefts June 2025






June 2022, 2023, 2024 & 2025 Break & Enter and Thefts

"Mandatory Alcohol Screening" (MAS) Statistics


In June 2025, a total of fifty Mandatory Alcohol Screening (MAS) tests were administered, resulting in three charges being laid under the Intermediate Roadside Suspensions (IRS) program. There were no charges related to the Alberta Zero Alcohol Tolerance (AZAT) for graduate drivers, and two 24-hour suspensions issued. There were also no impaired by alcohol or drug occurrences during the month.

Crimes Against Persons


5 Year Monthly Average – 30

Crimes Against Property


5 Year Monthly Average – 82

Drug Occurrences


5 Year Monthly Average – 6










