


#### **Crime Statistics Report Summary:**

Between June and July 2025, the community experienced a modest shift in crime trends across the eight key crime categories. While several crime types saw slight increases, the overall number of reported occurrences decreased during this period.


Despite isolated increases, particularly in violent crime types (assault, sexual assault, robbery), the notable decrease in theft (down 22) was a significant contributing factor to the overall downward trend.

Compared to the five-year average for July, which stands at 88 reported occurrences, current figures remain within a reasonable range, suggesting stable or improved community safety trends for the month.


### July 2025 Eight Crime Indicators Map




## Eight Crime Indicators Heat Map – July 2025




## Eight Crime Indicators Heat Map for 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter April - June, 2025




# Occurrence Zones Break & Enter and Thefts July 2025



#### "Mandatory Alcohol Screening" (MAS) Statistics


In July 2025, a total of 120 Mandatory Alcohol Screening (MAS) tests were administered, resulting in eight charges being laid under the Intermediate Roadside Suspensions (IRS) program. There were no charges related to the Alberta Zero Alcohol Tolerance (AZAT) for graduate drivers, and one 24-hour suspension issued. There were also no impaired by alcohol or drug occurrences during the month.

#### Drug Impaired Driving Tests

During the month of July 2025 there were no Standard Field Sobriety Tests (SFST) and no Drug Recognition Evaluation Test (DRE) performed.

#### **Crimes Against Persons**

5 Year Monthly Average – 31




The total number of Crimes against Persons was 44 in July of 2025, compared to 26 in July of 2024, 32 in July of 2023, and 36 in July of 2022.

In July 2025, the Crimes Against Persons category experienced an increase when compared to the five-year average for the same month. This rise was primarily driven by a notable uptick in assault-related incidents, which involved other criminal code offences not captured in the eight crime indicators. Of the 20 reported assault occurrences, 18 were linked to violence involving intimate partners, family members, or friends.

#### **Crimes Against Property**


5 Year Monthly Average – 79

#### **Drug Occurrences**


5 Year Monthly Average – 3








