## Executive Summary:

February 2026 presented a substantial 44% reduction in the eight key crime indicators compared to January 2026, along with notable decreases from both February 2025 and the five-year average.

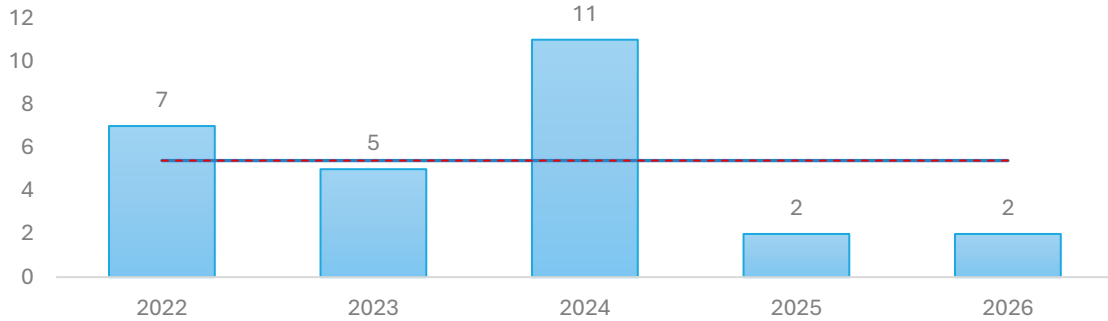
Crimes Against Persons recorded a slight increase in criminal harassment occurrences and now sits five incidents above the five-year average overall. Assaults accounted for 40% of all reported incidents this month; however, the number of assault occurrences remained consistent with both January 2026 and February 2025.

Crimes Against Property decreased by 30% relative to the five-year average. While fraud incidents increased, significant reductions in theft of motor vehicle, theft under \$5,000, and mischief were the primary contributors to the overall decline.

Overall, the total number of incidents across the eight key crime indicators reached its lowest level in five years. Targeted, proactive priorities—particularly those emphasizing offender management, theft prevention, and motor-vehicle theft reduction—proved effective.

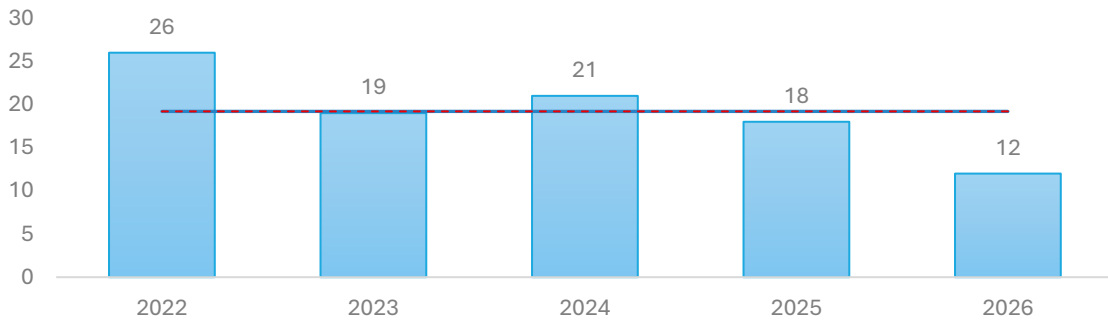

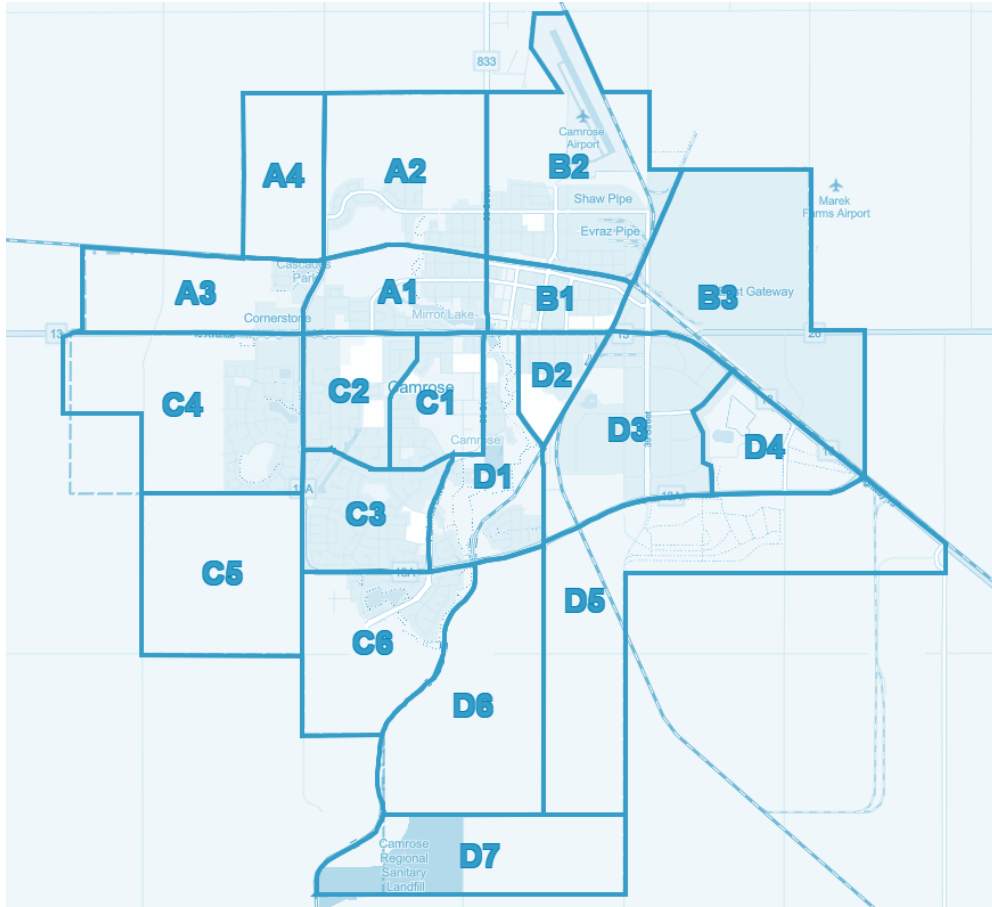
5 Year Average - 19

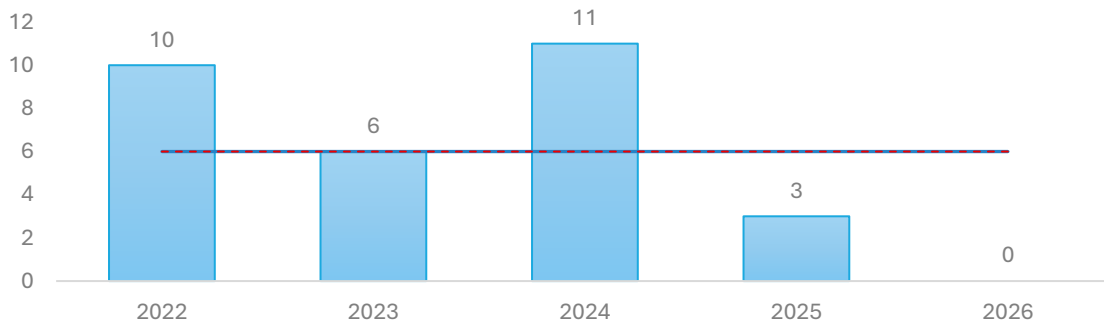
Occurrence Zones





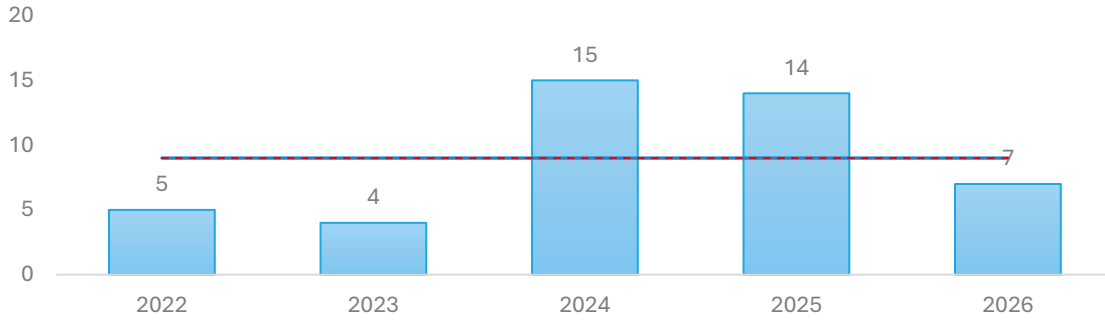
# Theft of Motor Vehicle

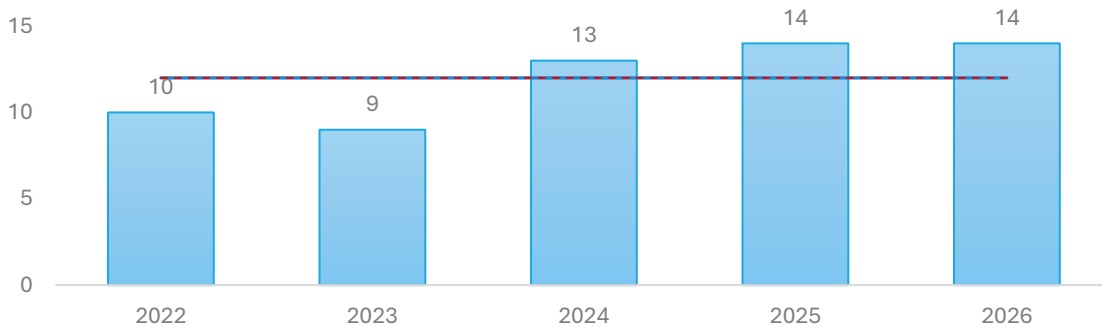

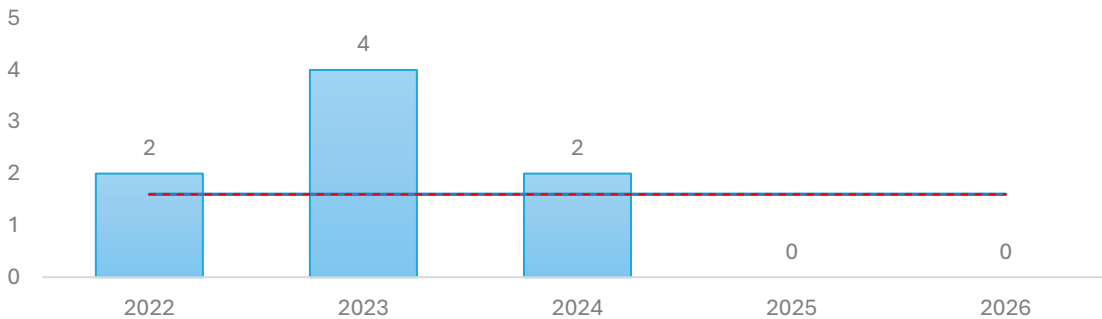

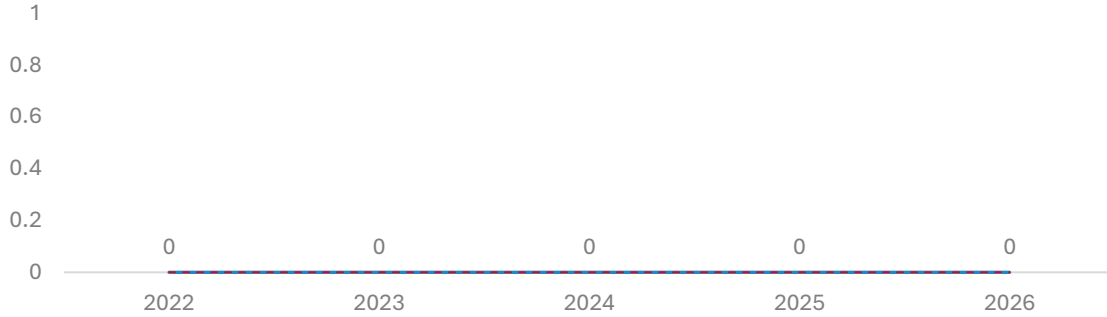

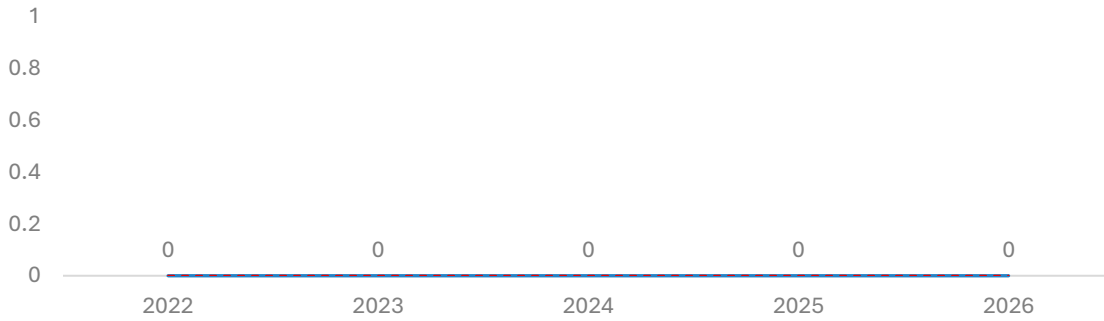

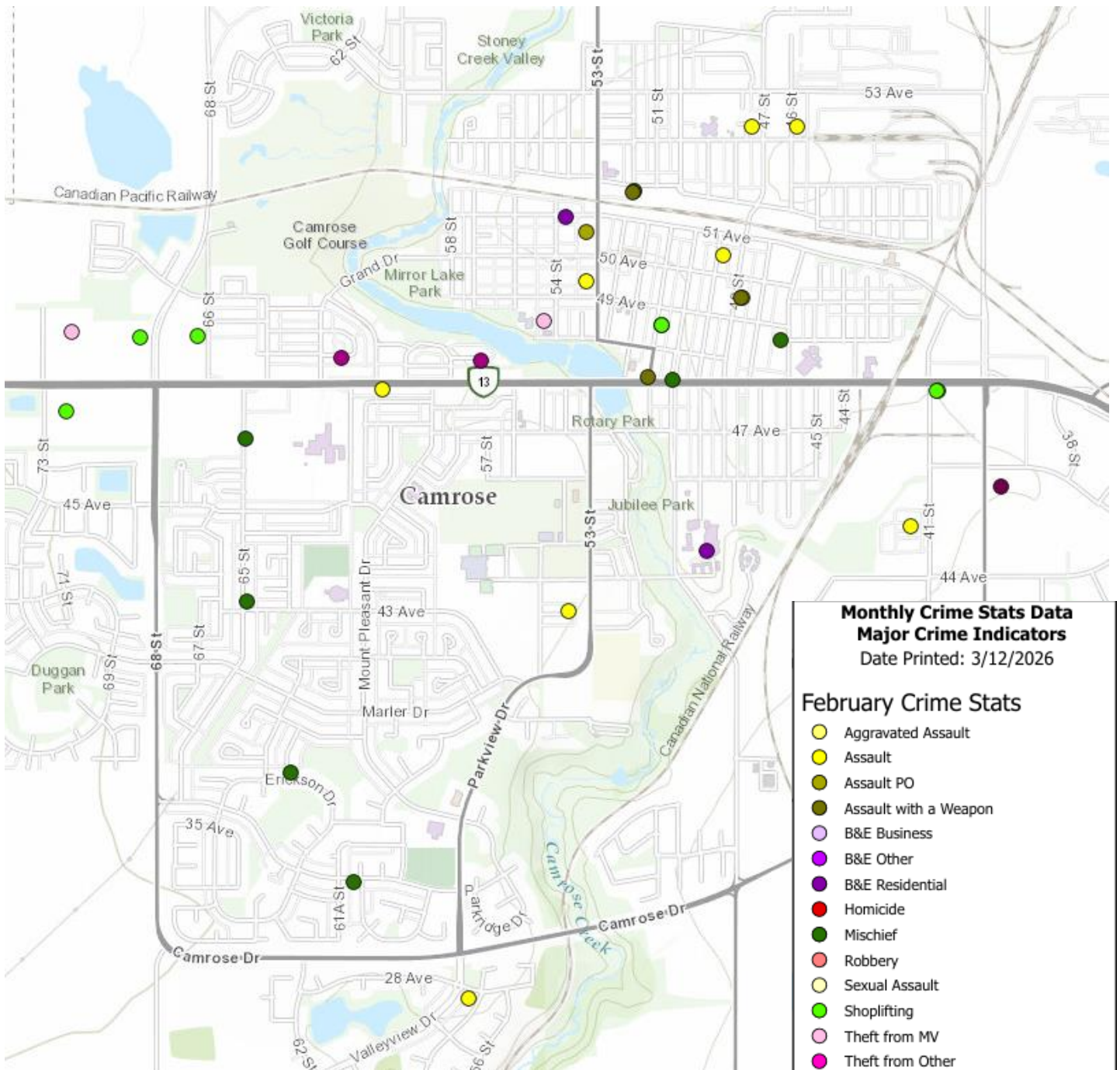

# February 2026 Eight Crime Indicators Map

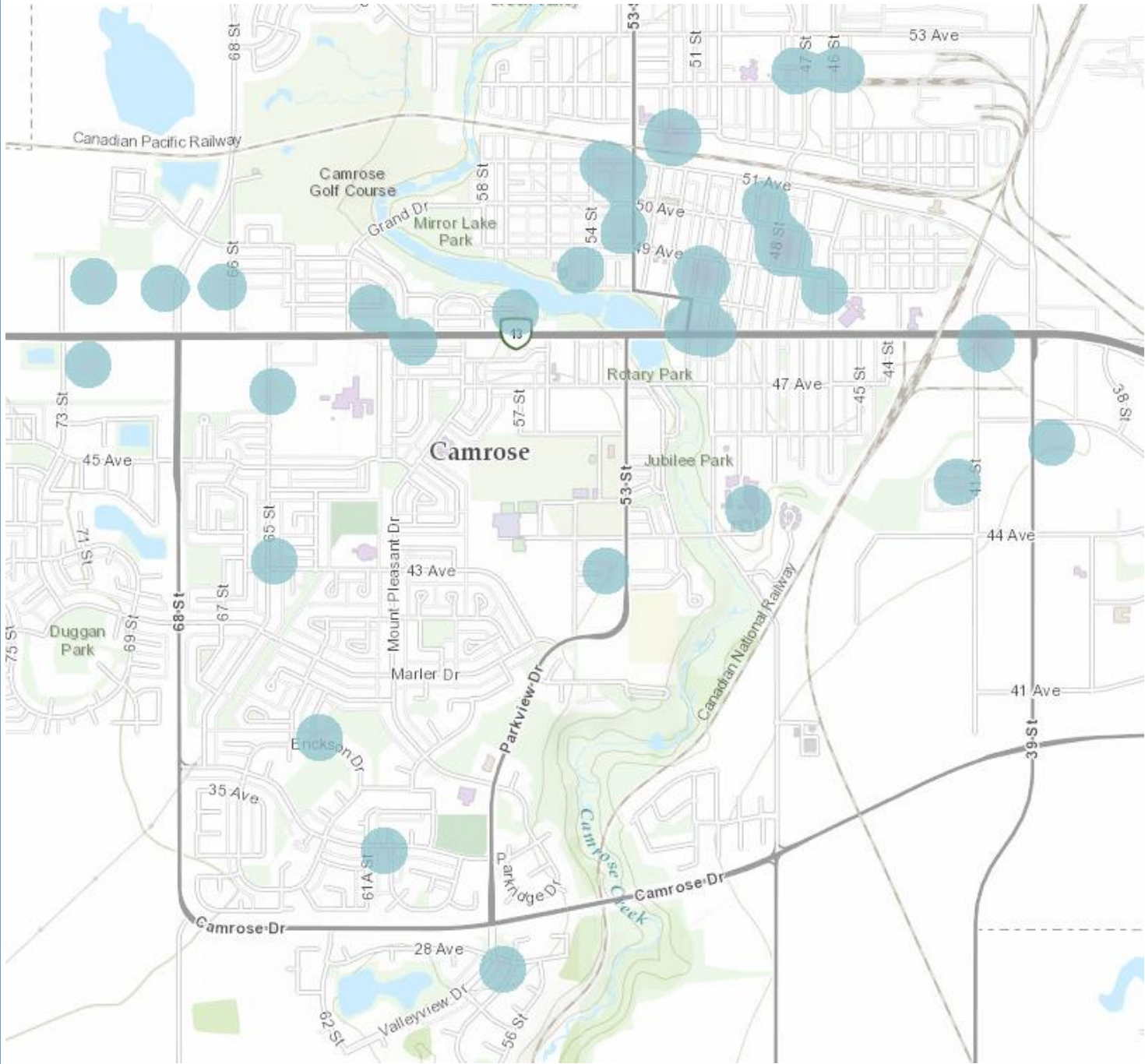

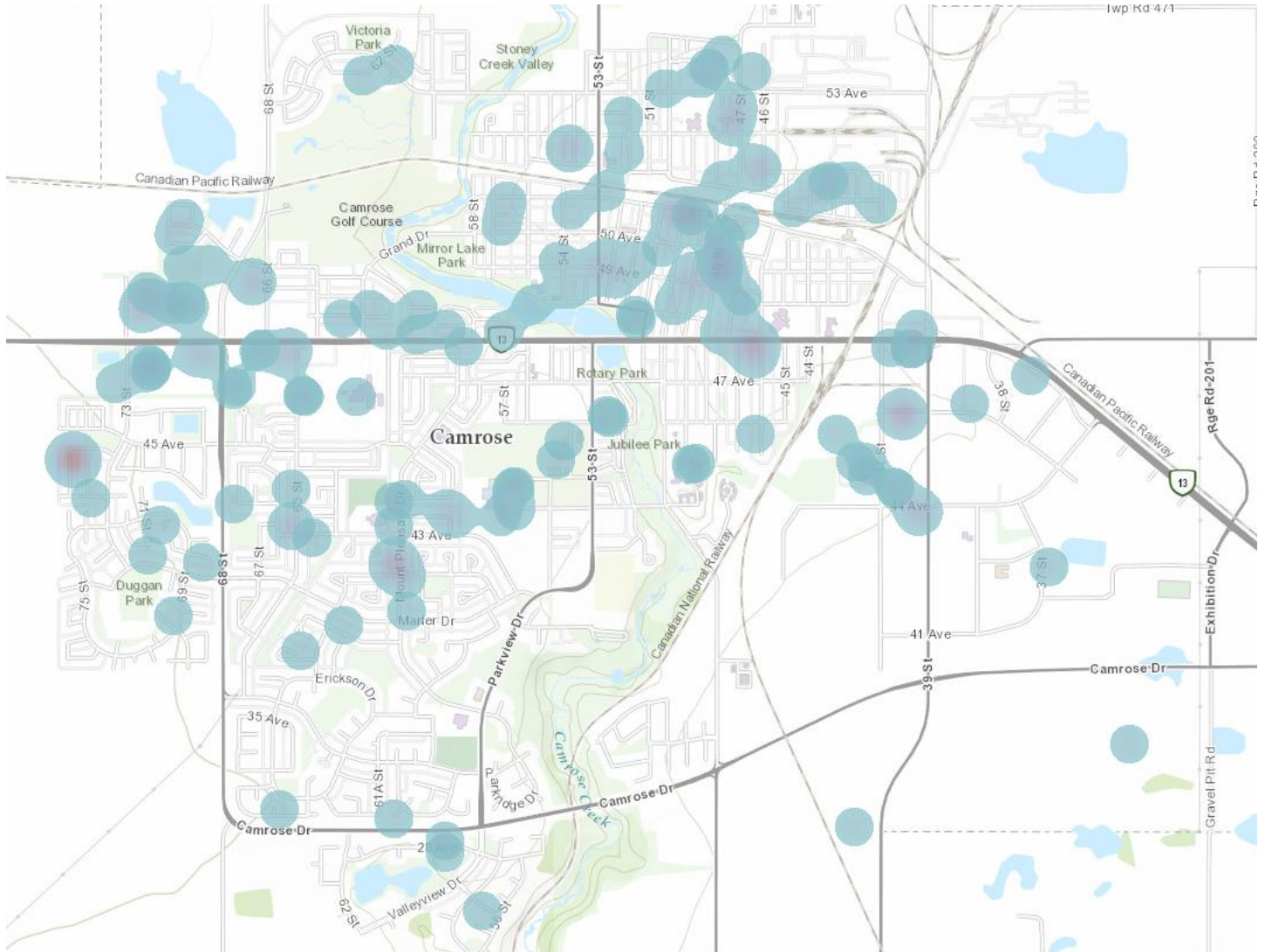

# Eight Crime Indicators Heat Map – February 2026

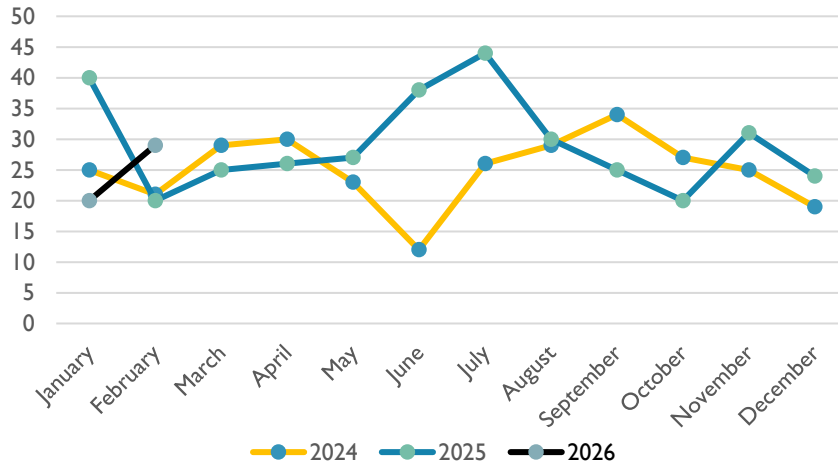


# Eight Crime Indicators Heat Map for 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter October - December, 2025



# Crimes Against Persons

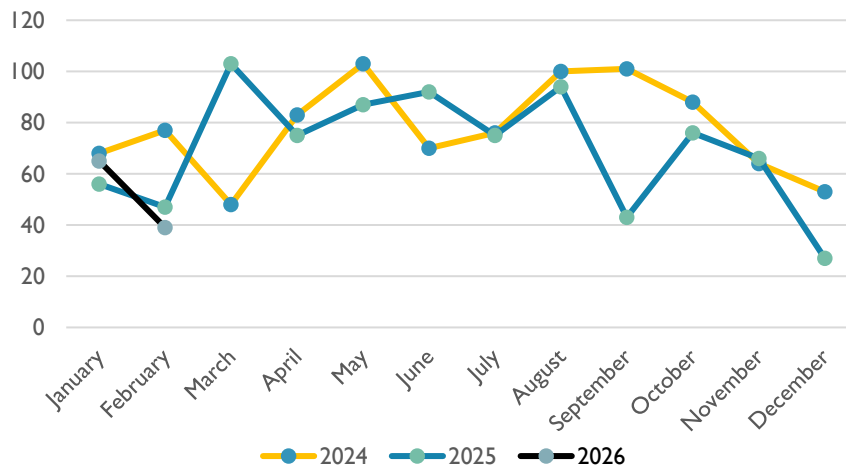
5 Year Monthly Average – 24

# Crimes Against Property

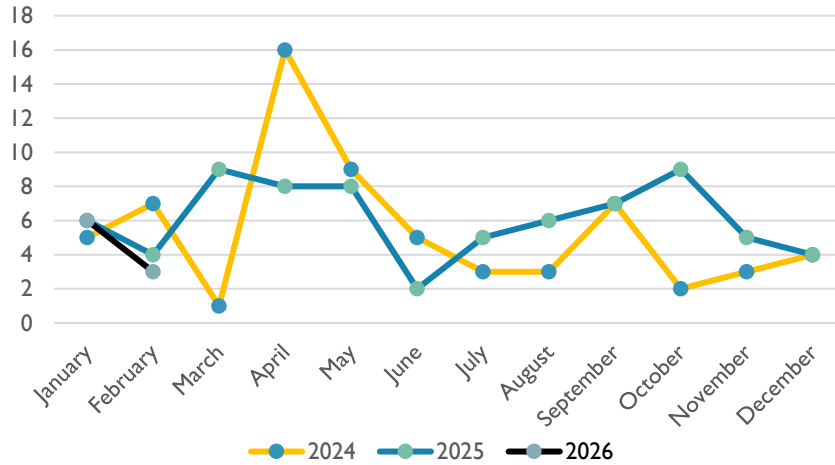
5 Year Monthly Average – 56

# Drug Occurrences

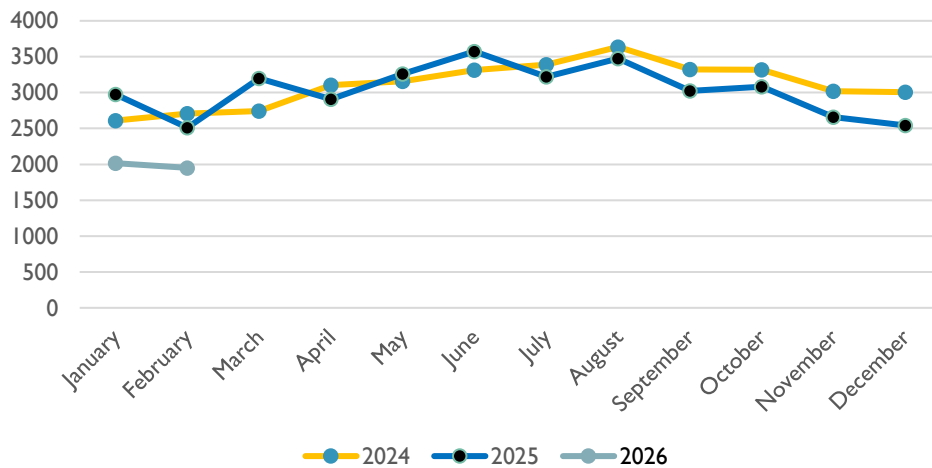
5 Year Monthly Average – 4

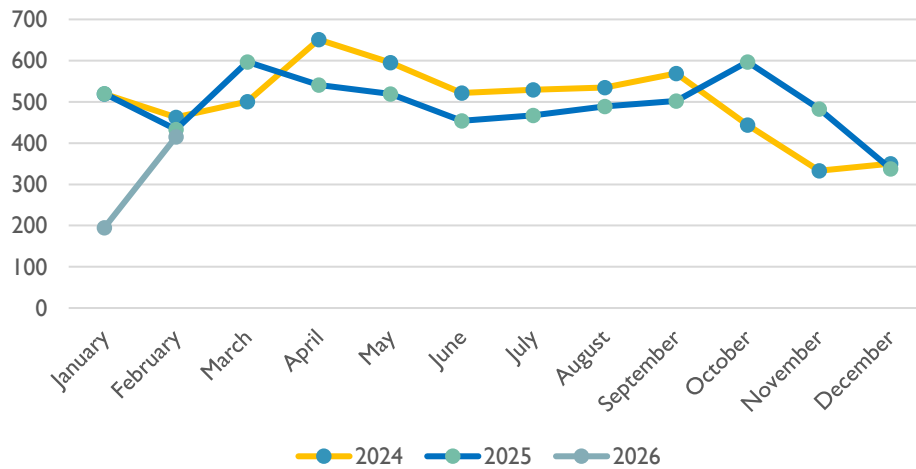

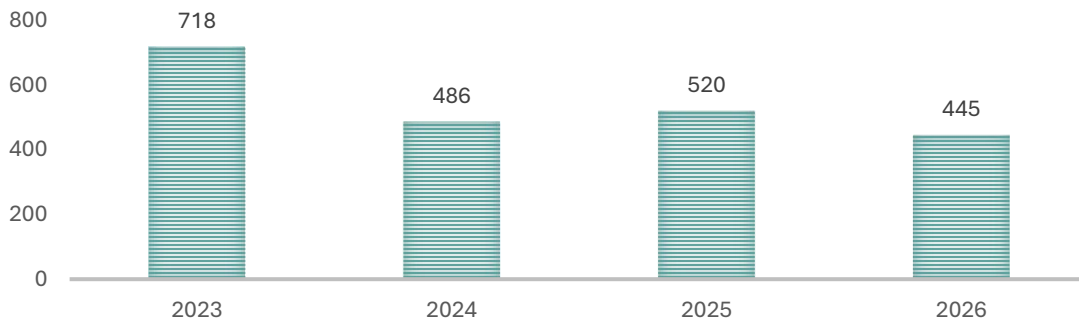

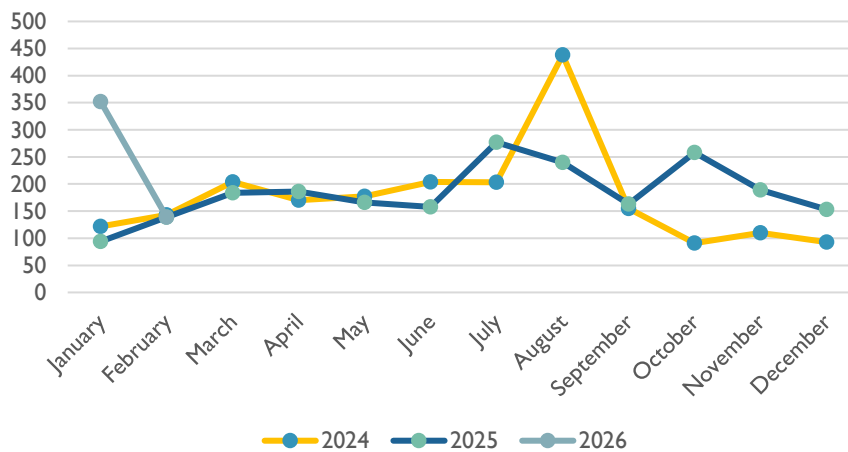

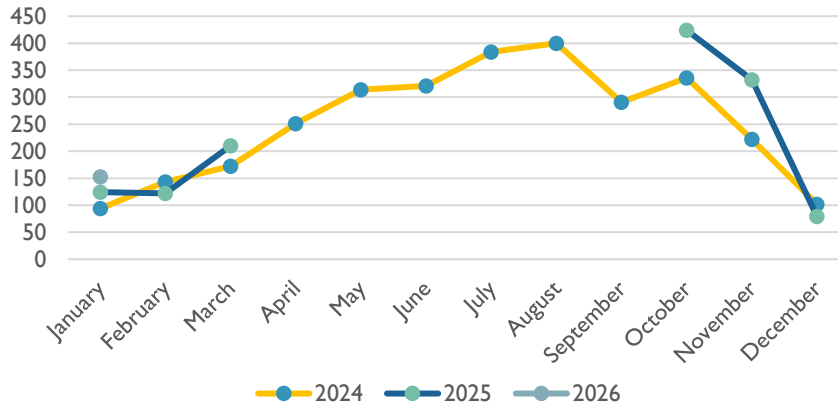

The Intersection Safety Device located at 68 Street & 48 Avenue was effective from February 1, 2020, however was not operational from April 1, 2025 to October 9, 2025. The device was reactivated on October 10, 2025.

## **“Mandatory Alcohol Screening” (MAS) Statistics**

In February 2026, officers conducted **57 Mandatory Alcohol Screening (MAS)** tests, resulting in **four charges** under the **Immediate Roadside Sanctions (IRS)** program. No charges were issued under the **Alberta Zero Alcohol Tolerance (AZAT)** provisions for Graduated Driver Licensing participants, and no **24-hour suspensions** were recorded. Overall, **7% of all drivers tested** were found to be in contravention of applicable alcohol-related sanctions.

There were also no impaired by alcohol or drug occurrences during the month.

## **Drug Impaired Driving Tests**

During the month of February 2026 there were **no Standard Field Sobriety Tests (SFST)** or **Drug Recognition Evaluation Test (DRE)** performed.
