Purpose:

The purpose of this report is to provide a standardized monthly analysis of crime trends within the City of Camrose. The report focuses on eight primary crime indicators and presents statistical comparisons, trends, and contextual analysis to support operational decision-making, strategic planning, and community awareness.

Data Sources & Methodology:

Data contained in this report is derived from police Records Management Systems (RMS), Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD), and internal statistical tracking. Occurrence counts reflect reported incidents and may be subject to change as investigations continue or late reports are received.

Executive Summary:

The August 2026 Monthly Crime Analysis Report indicates an overall reduction in crime across Camrose when compared to both the previous month and the same period last year. The eight primary crime indicators totalled 67 occurrences, representing a 24% decrease from July 2026 (88) and a 32% decrease from August 2025 (98), while also remaining well below the five-year August average of 89 occurrences.

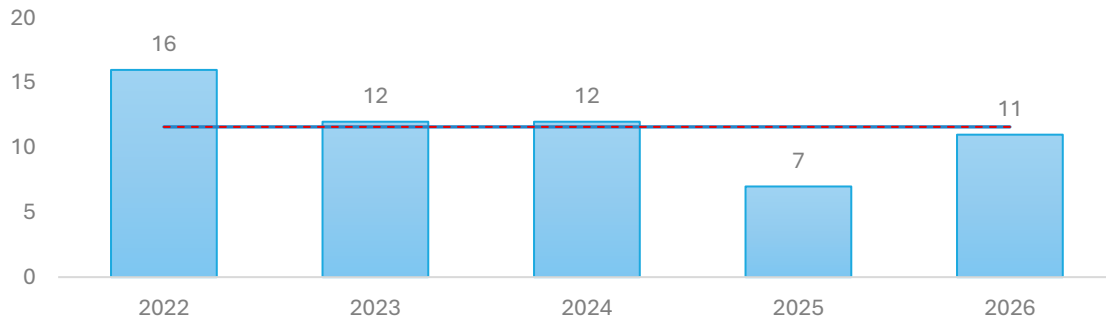
Property crime showed notable improvement during the month. Theft offences declined significantly to 16 occurrences, down from 34 in July and 30 in August 2025, placing theft well below the five-year average of 32. Crimes Against Property overall totalled 57 occurrences, compared to 96 in August 2025 and 100 in August 2024. While most property crime categories decreased, Break and Enter occurrences increased to 11, up from 7 during the same month last year, driven primarily by commercial break-ins, although still remaining near the historical average of 12. Theft of Motor Vehicles remained stable at four incidents.

Violent crime levels remained moderate. Crimes Against Persons totalled 30 occurrences, matching the five-year monthly average and representing a decrease from 34 occurrences in August 2025. Assaults declined from 25 last year to 17 this August and remained slightly below the historical average. Sexual assaults totalled three occurrences, consistent with both last year and the five-year average.

Overall, August 2026 was characterized by lower crime volumes, substantial reductions in theft and property crime, and stable violent crime levels.

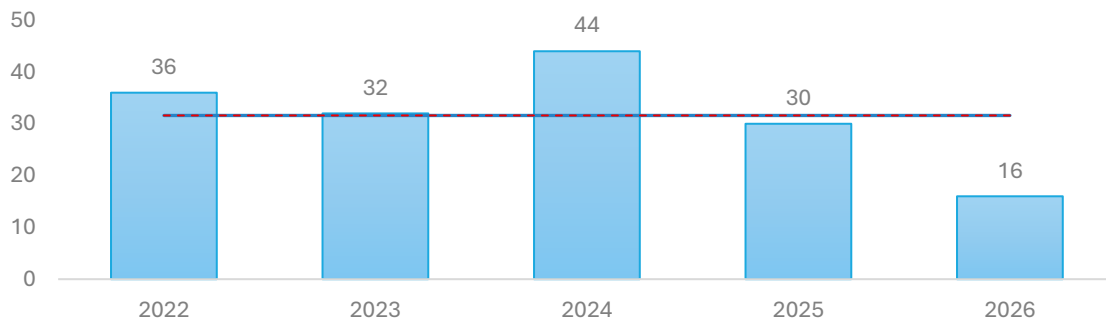

5 Year Average - 12



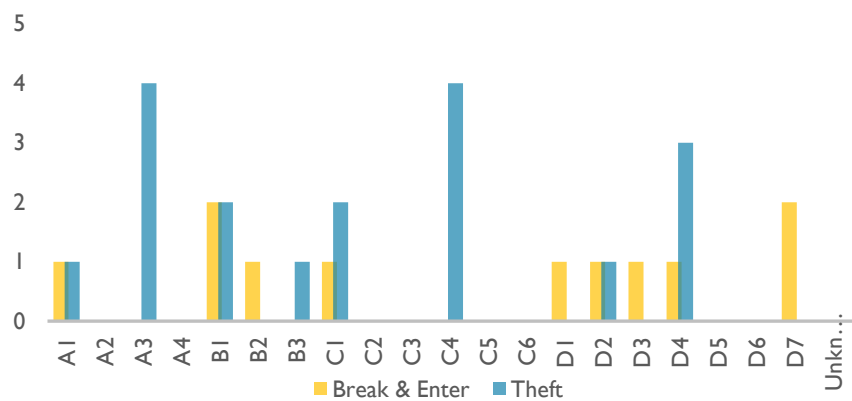
Theft

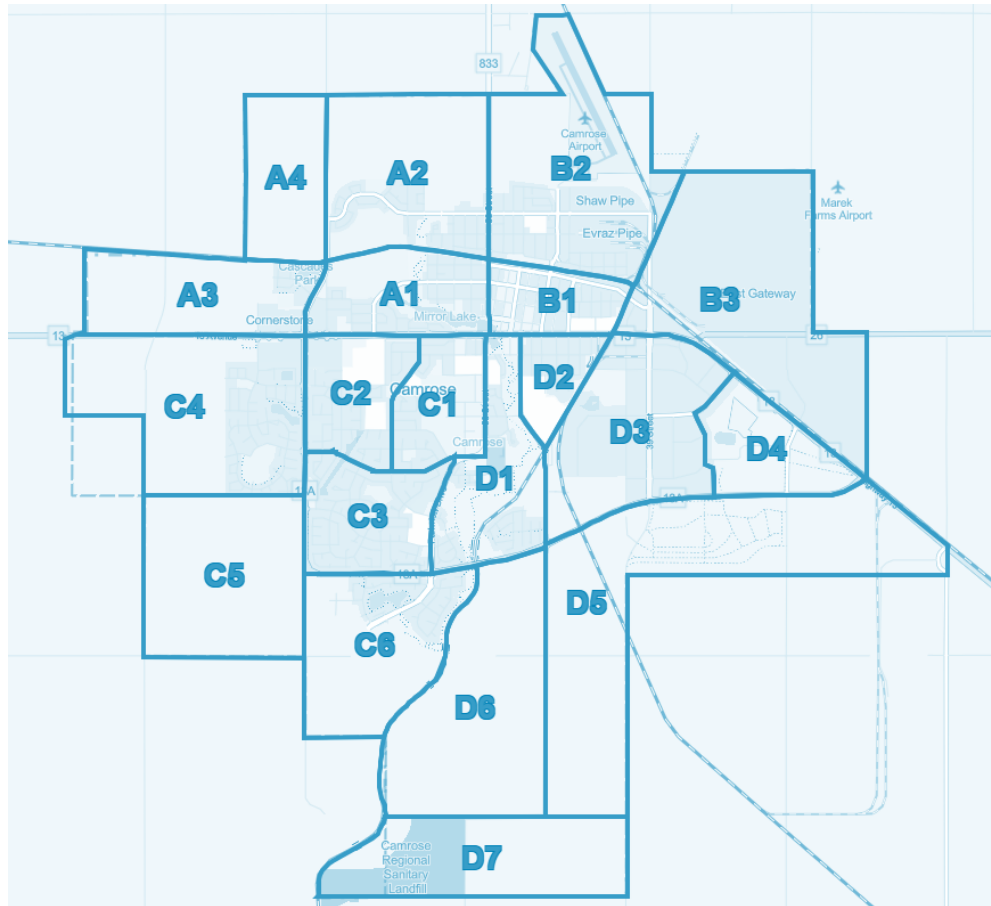
5 Year Average - 32



Break & Enter and Theft

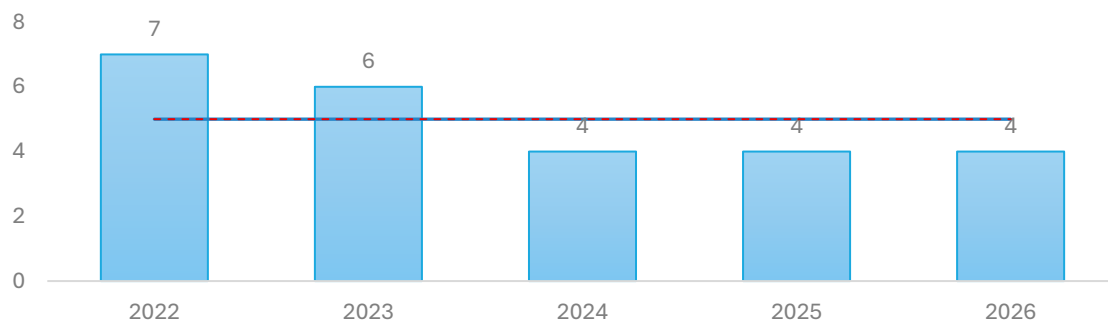
Occurrence Zones





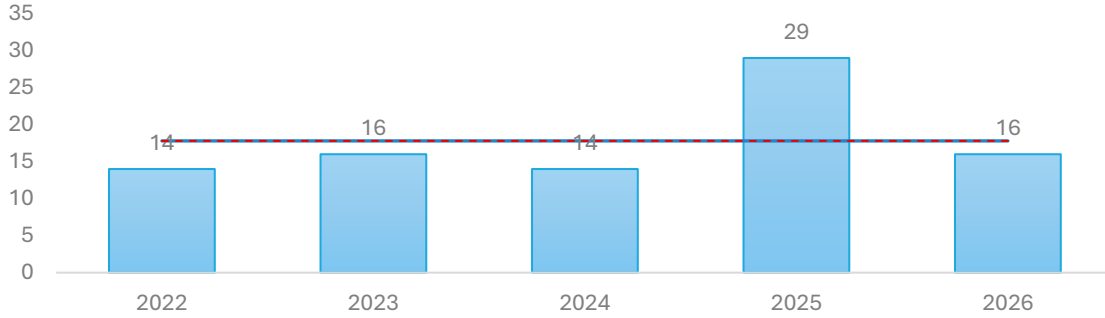
Theft of Motor Vehicle

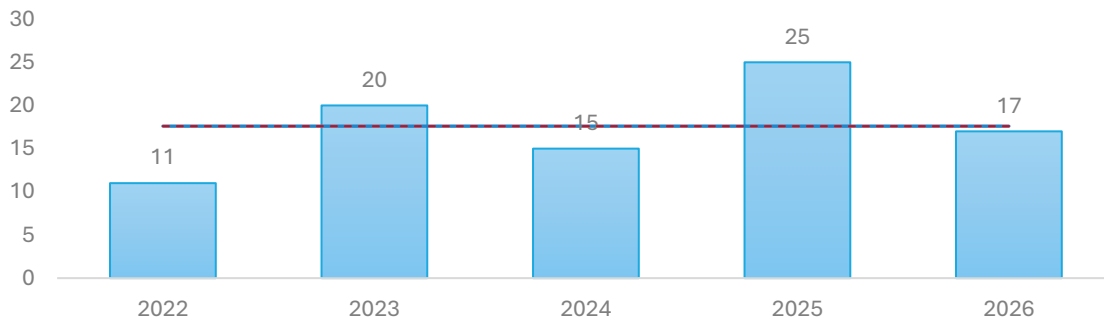

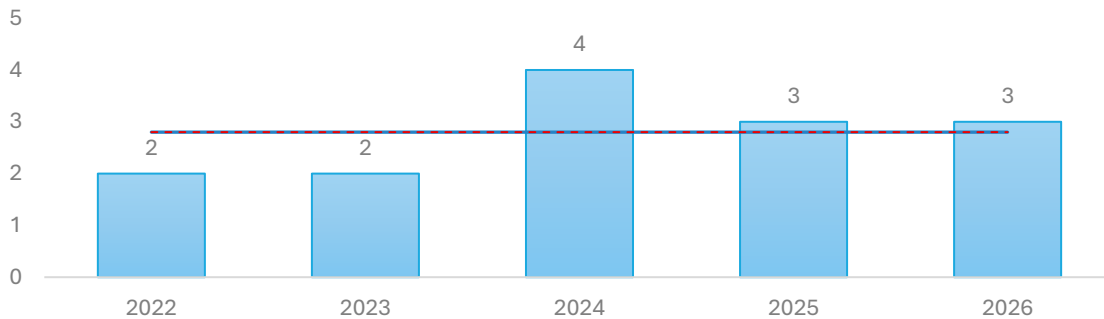

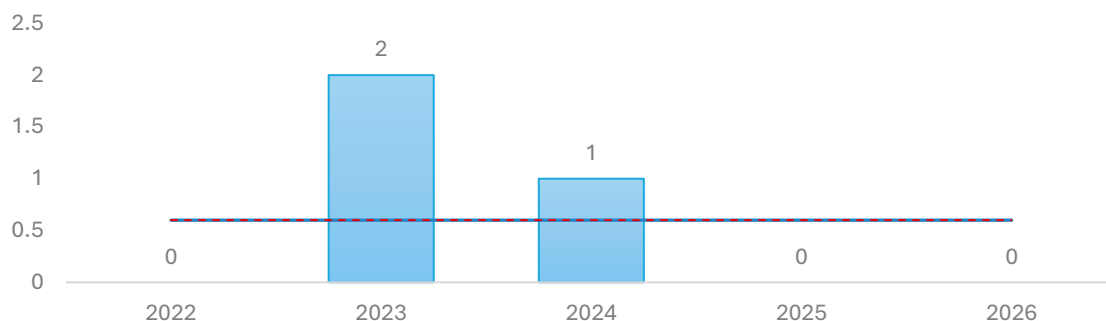

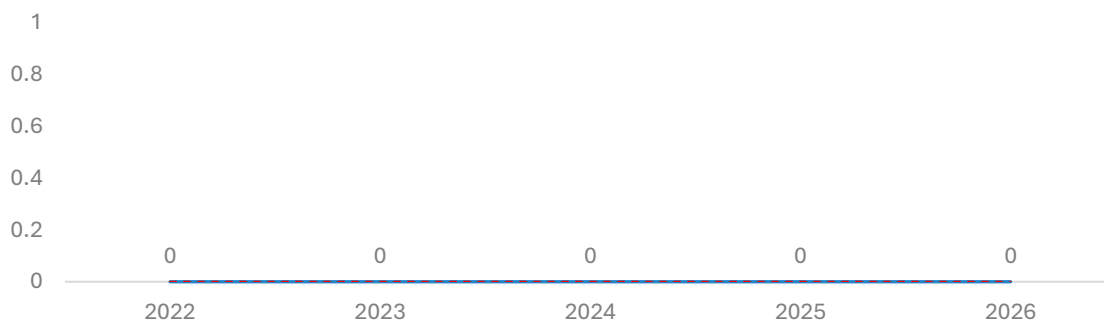

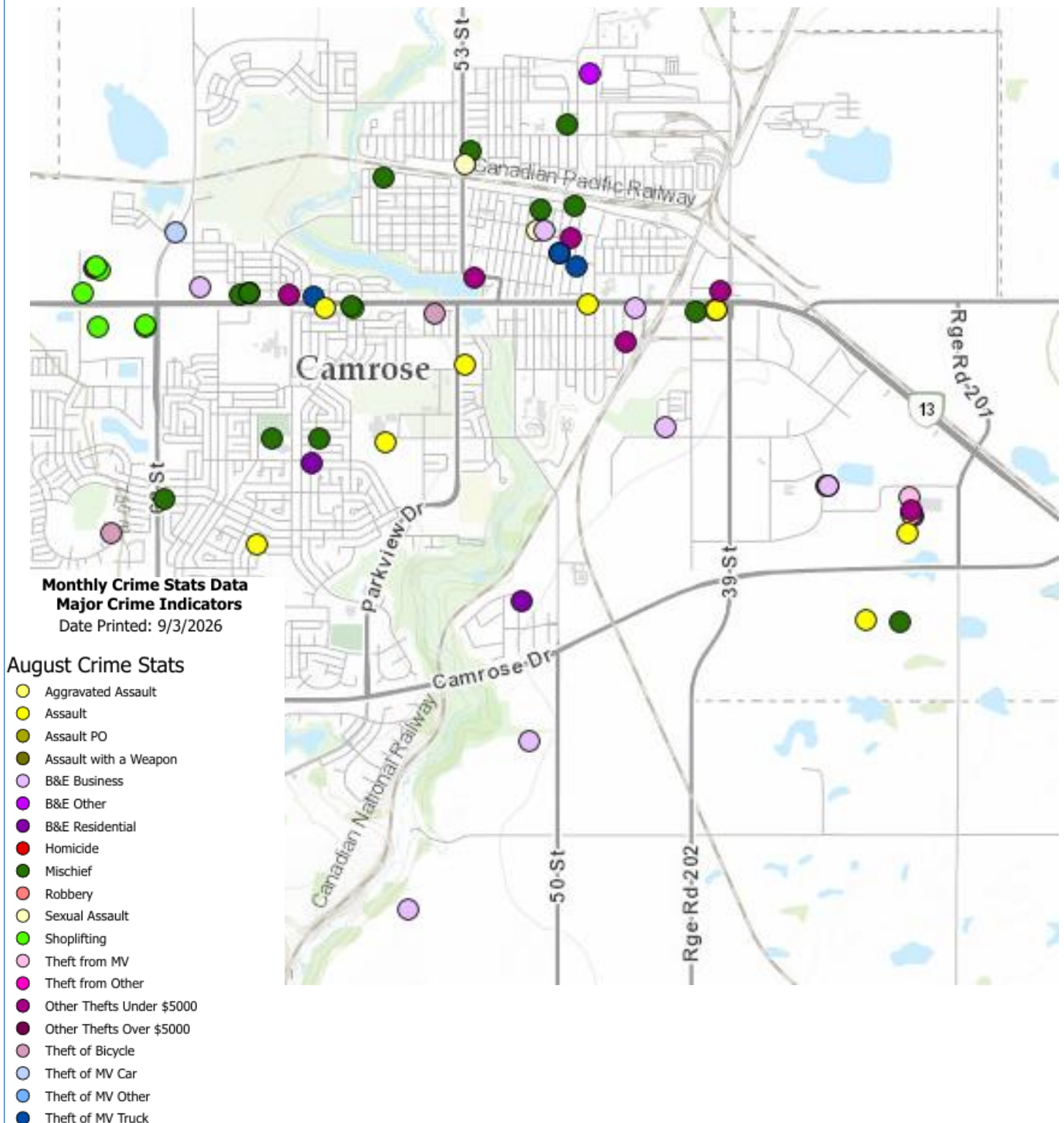

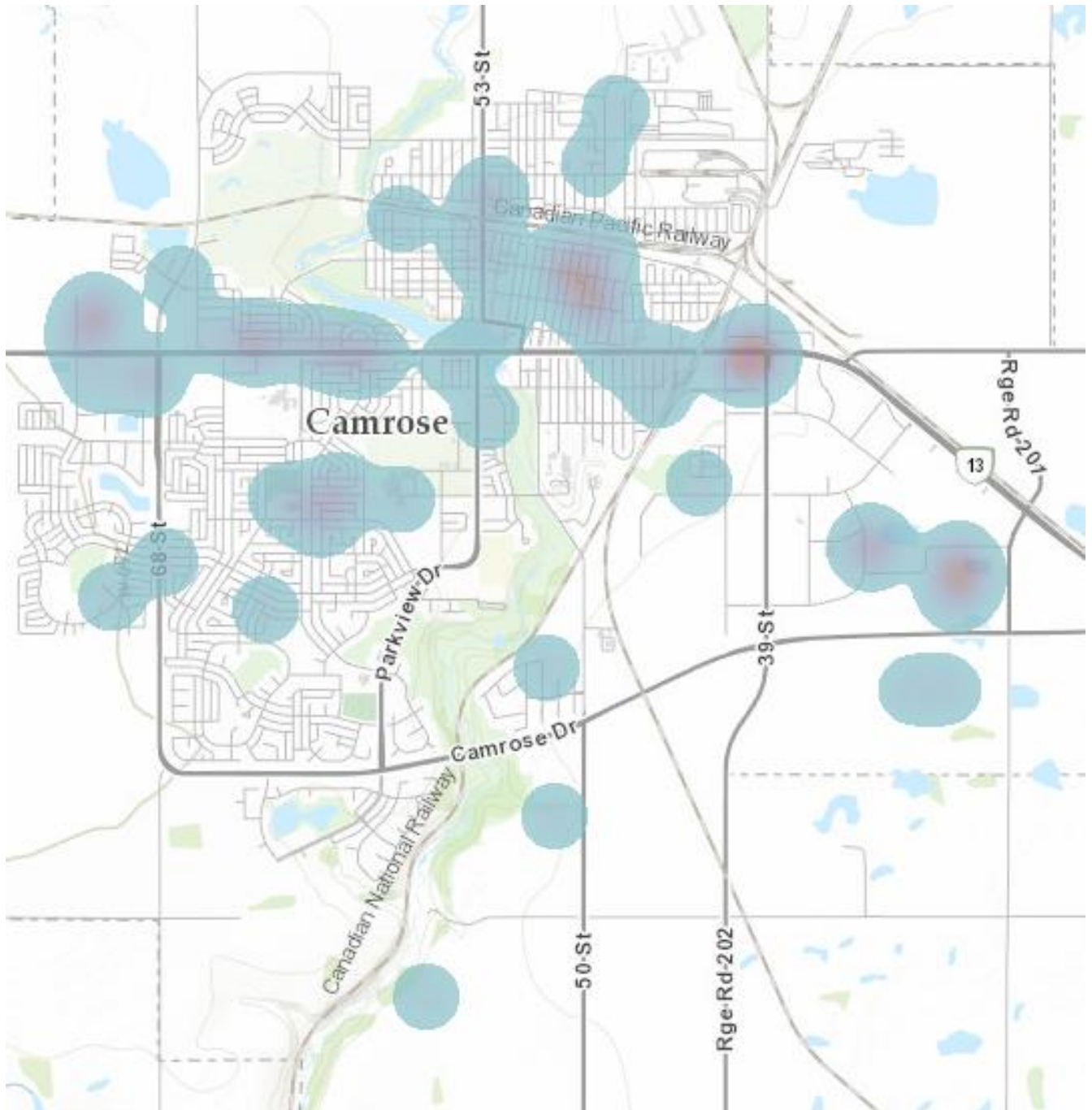

August 2026 Eight Crime Indicators Map



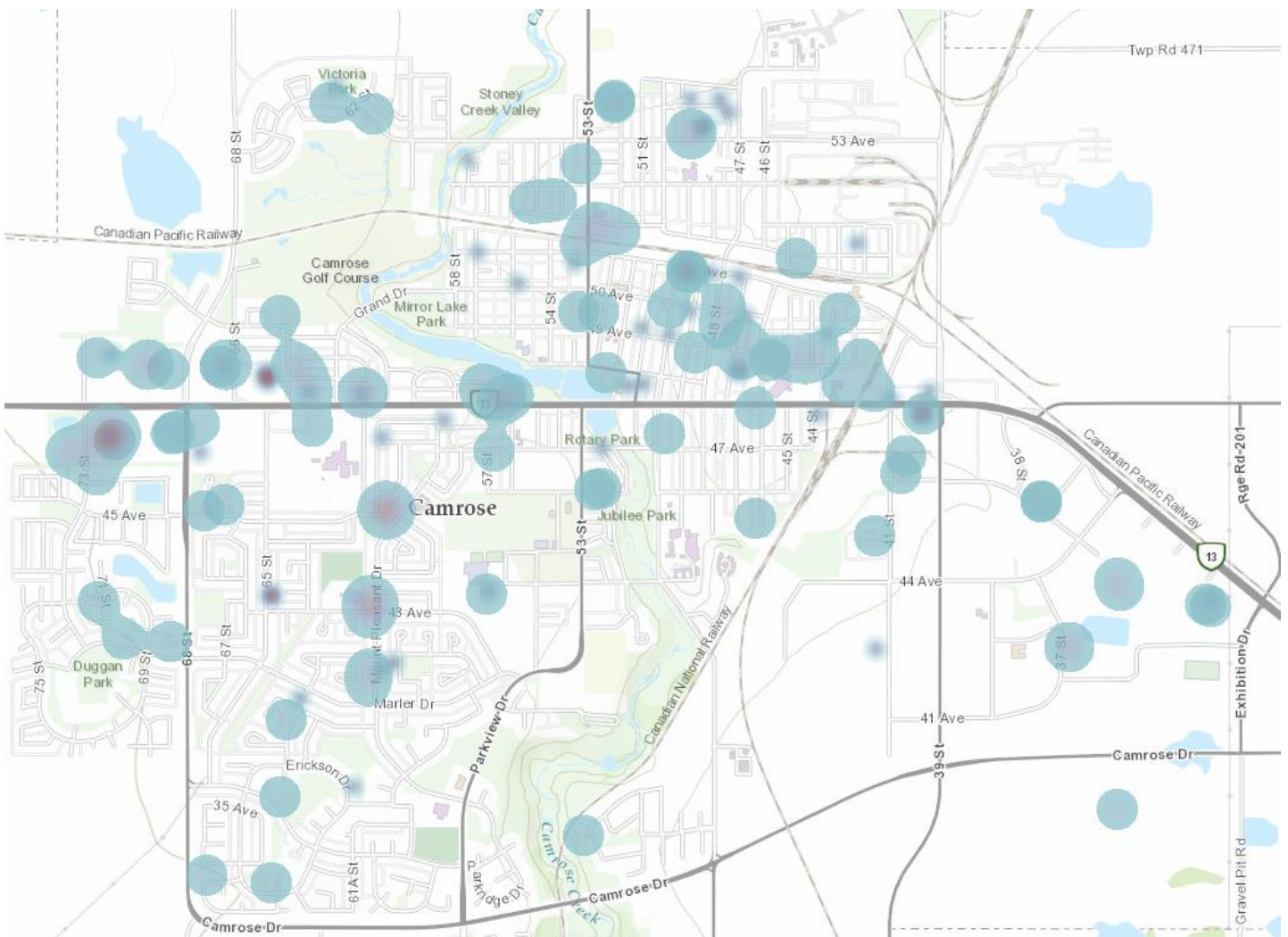
Eight Crime Indicators Heat Map – August 2026



Eight Crime Indicators Heat Map

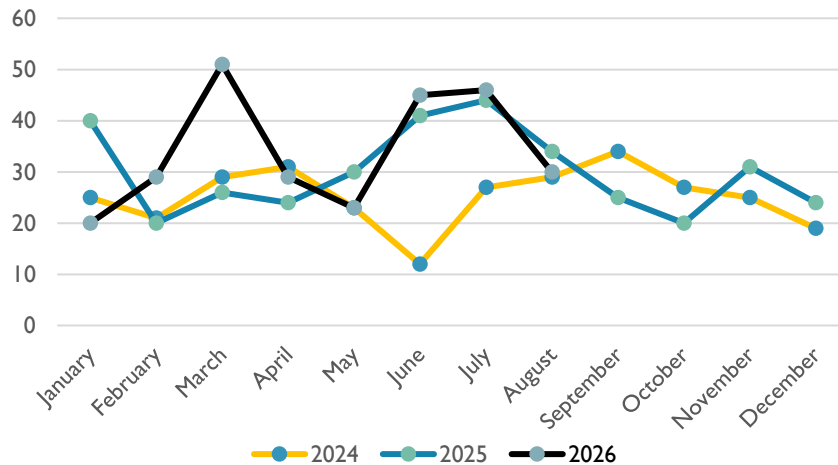

Crimes Against Persons

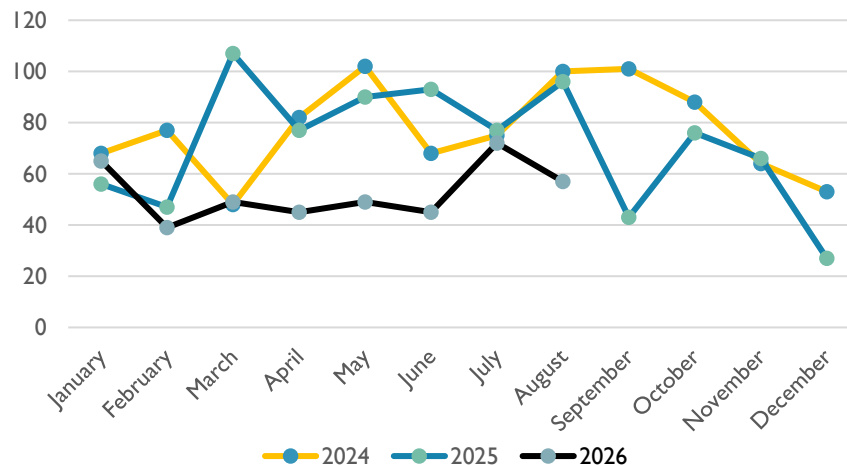
5 Year Monthly Average – 30

Crimes Against Property

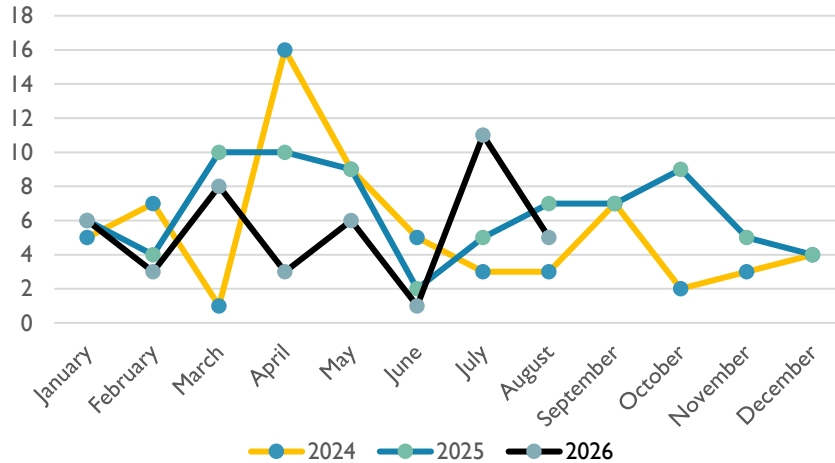
5 Year Monthly Average – 86

5 Year Monthly Average – 5

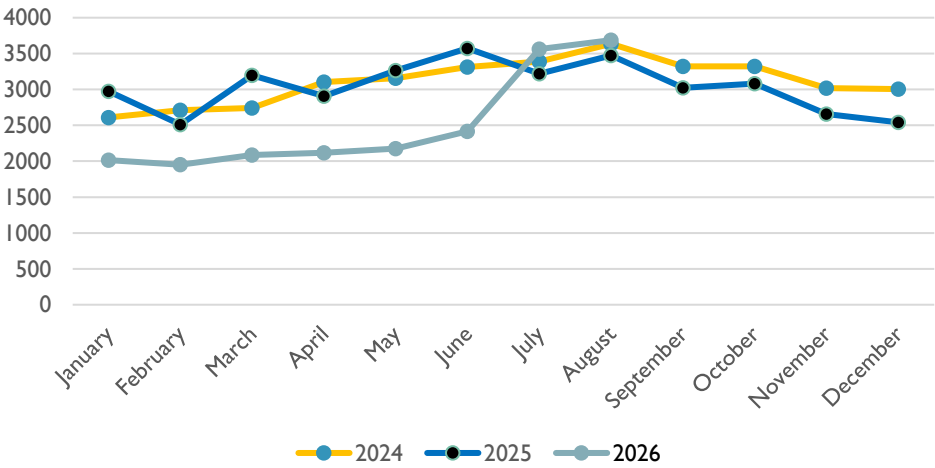


There were 5 drug offence occurrences in August of 2026, compared to 7 occurrences in August of 2025 and 3 occurrences in August of 2024.

Month-to-month fluctuations in drug offence occurrences are often influenced by the length of proactive investigations before they are concluded

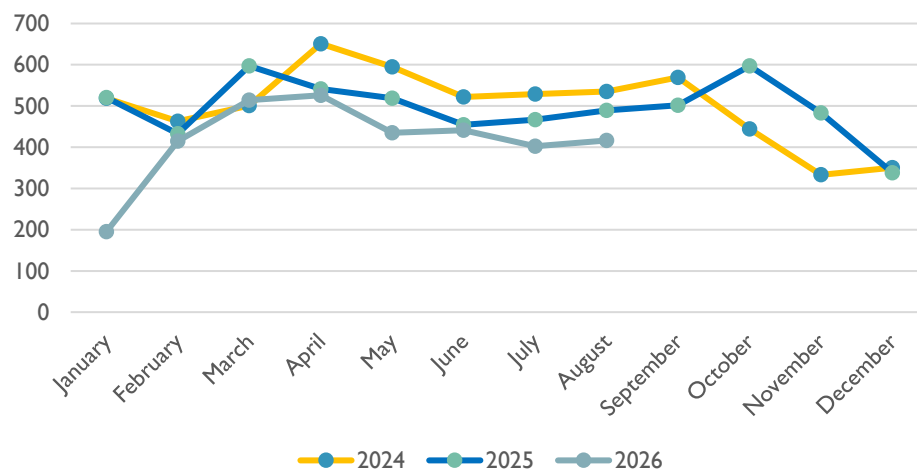

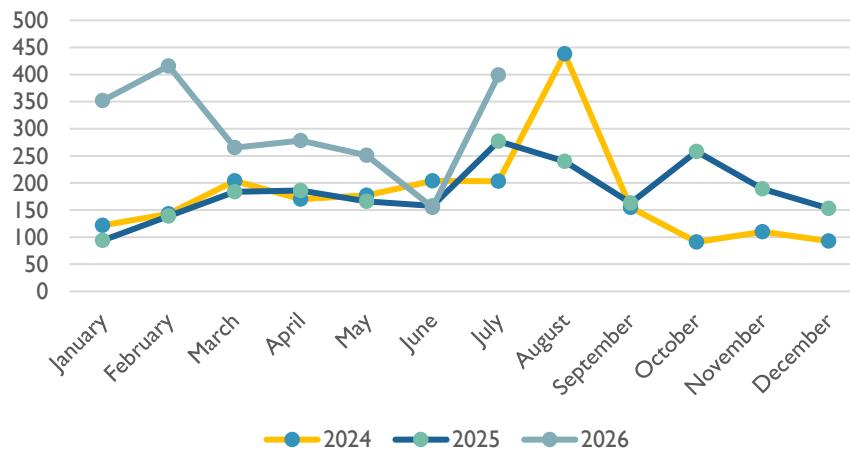

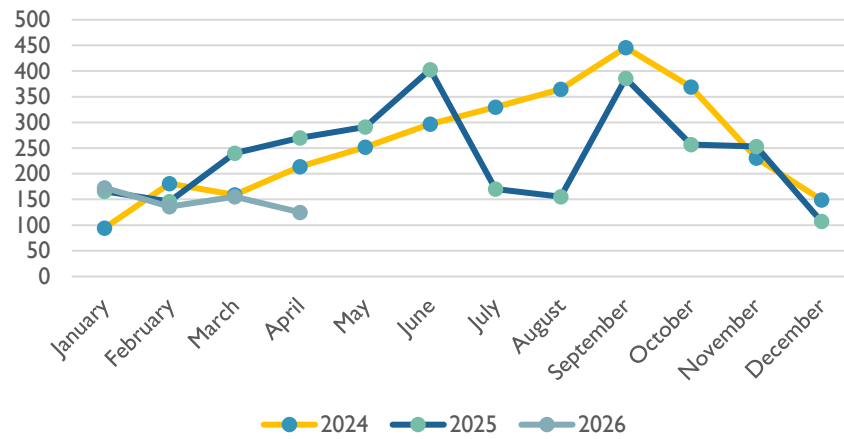

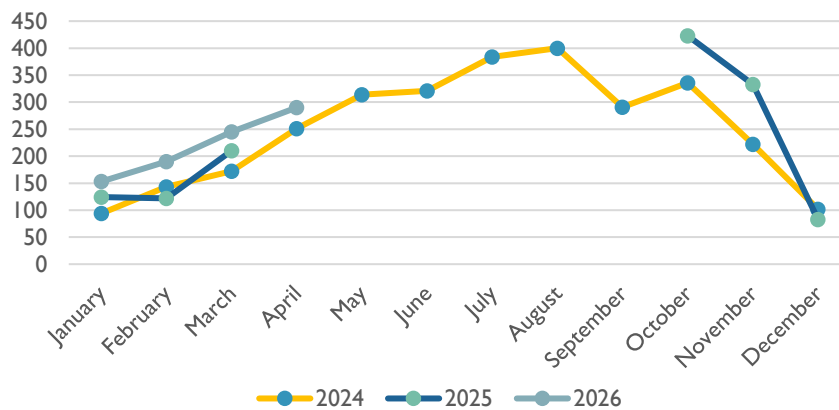

The Intersection Safety Device located at 68 Street & 48 Avenue was effective from February 1, 2020, however was not operational from April 1, 2025 to October 9, 2025. The device was reactivated on October 10, 2025.

“Mandatory Alcohol Screening” (MAS) Statistics

In August 2026, officers conducted **525 Mandatory Alcohol Screening (MAS)** tests, resulting in **14 charges** under the **Immediate Roadside Sanctions (IRS)** program. **One** charge was issued under the **Alberta Zero Alcohol Tolerance (AZAT)** provisions for Graduated Driver Licensing participants, and **three 24-hour suspensions** were recorded. Overall, **3% of all drivers tested** were found to be in contravention of applicable alcohol-related sanctions.

There were **two** impaired by alcohol or drug occurrences during the month.

Drug Impaired Driving Tests

In the month of August 2026 there was **one Standard Field Sobriety Test (SFST)** and **no Drug Recognition Evaluation Tests (DRE)** performed.
