
Overview:

The statistic for the eight crime indicators for October, 2023, recorded an 8% increase (or 7 reported occurrences) from the September, 2023 statistic, and is 13% higher than the five-year average for October. Significant increases were captured in the categories of mischief and assault.


A review of the mischief occurrences revealed 10 occurrences involved damage to residences (3 involving domestic violence), 9 occurrences involved damaged vehicles (2 involving domestic violence), and 3 occurrences of youths knocking on residential doors and then fleeing. The majority of these occurrences occurred in zone B1, B2 and C2.


A review of the assault occurrences determined 9 occurrences involved intimate partner/familial violence, 6 occurrences of assault took place in public locations involving subjects known to each other, 1 occurrence took place at a school and 1 occurrence of assault police officer.

October 2023 Eight Crime Indicators Map




Occurrence Zones Break & Enter and Thefts – October 2023






October 2020, 2021, 2022 & 2023 Break & Enter and Thefts

"Mandatory Alcohol Screening" (MAS) Statistics



Crimes Against Persons


5 Year Monthly Average – 30

Crimes Against Property


5 Year Monthly Average – 83

Drug Occurrences


5 Year Monthly Average – 6










