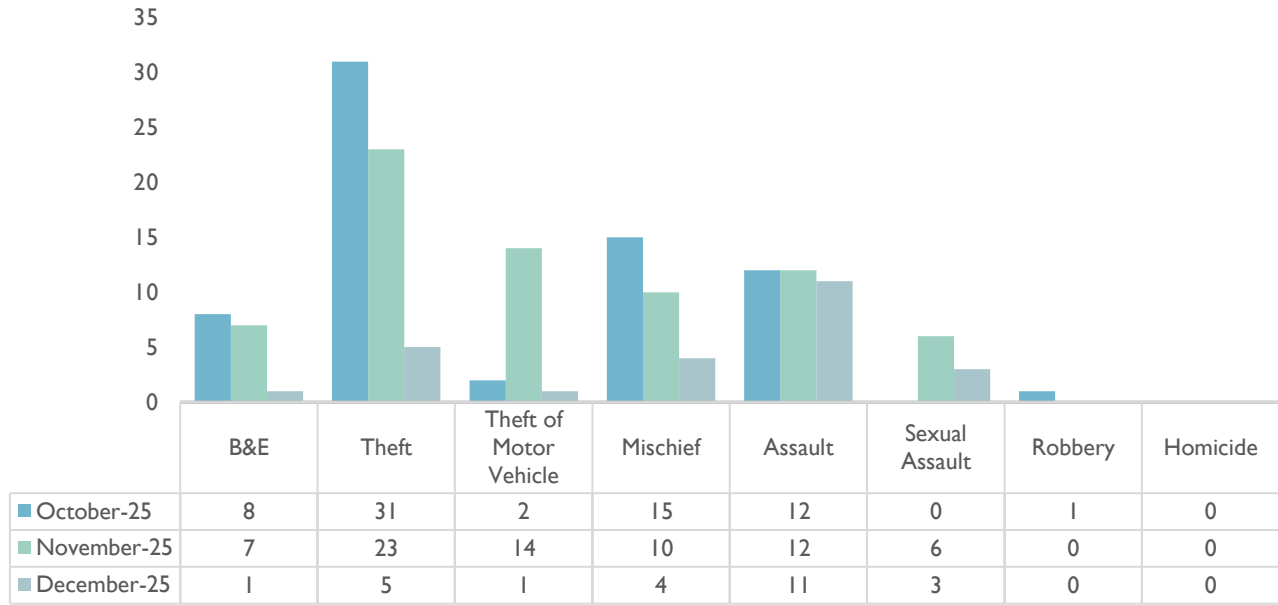

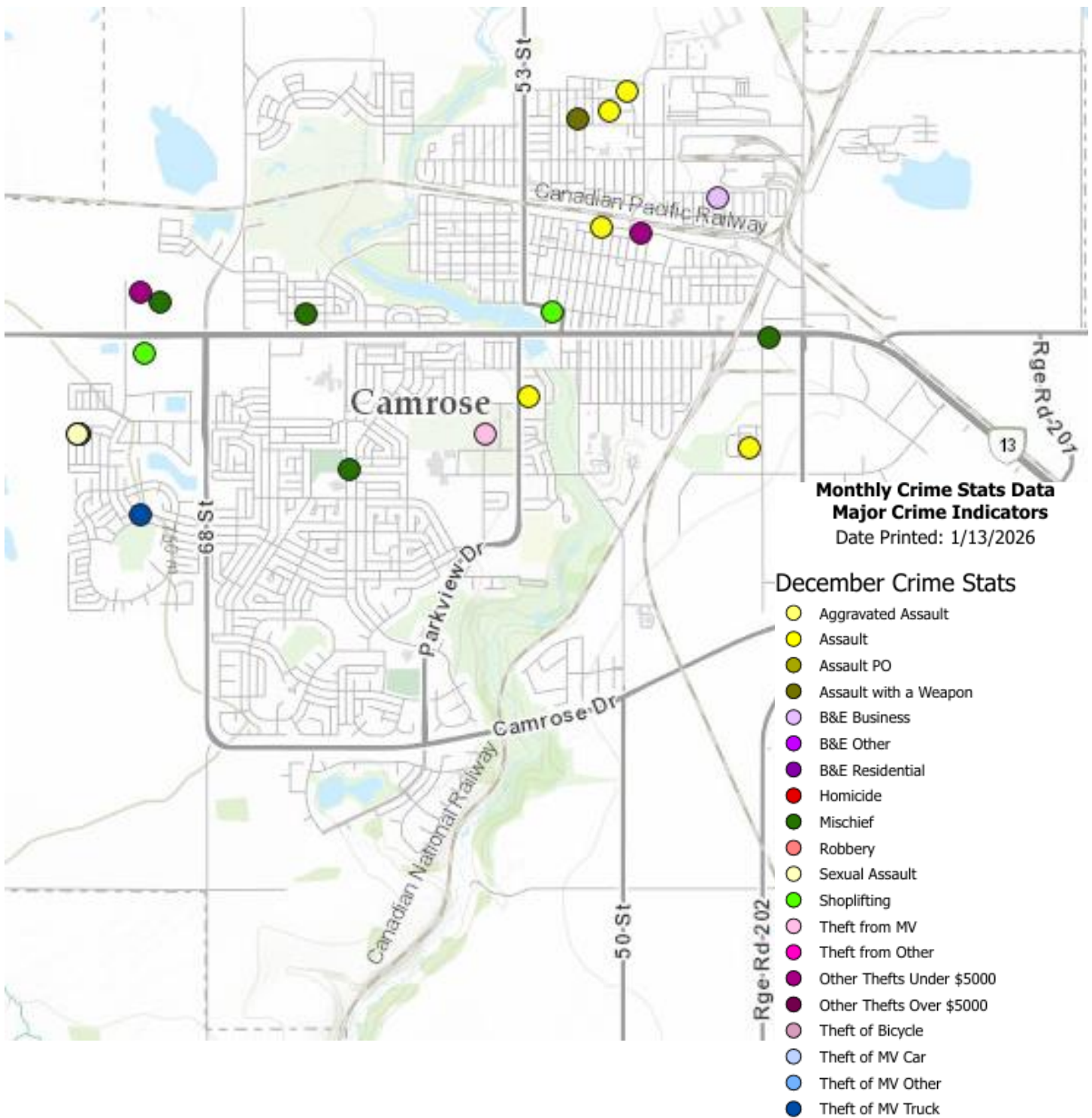
### Crime Statistics Report Summary:

An analysis of the eight primary crime indicators for October through December 2025 indicates an overall downward trend in reported crime toward year-end. Theft remained the most prevalent offence; however, reported occurrences declined significantly each month, from a high in October to substantially lower levels in December. Break and enter and mischief offences also demonstrated consistent decreases across the reporting period.

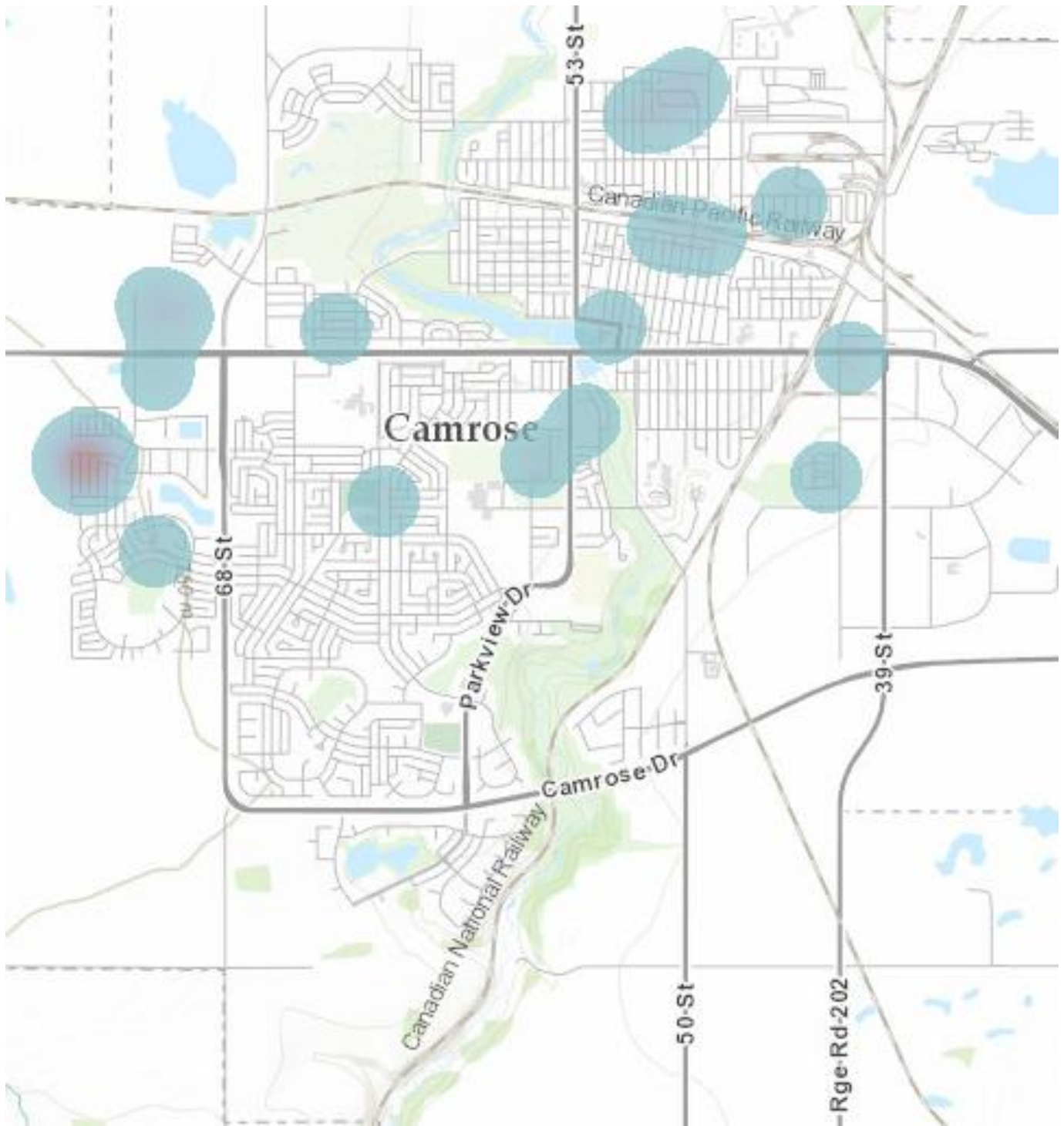
November 2025 experienced short-term increases in theft of motor vehicle and sexual assault, representing notable but isolated spikes within the quarter. Assault occurrences remained relatively stable throughout the period, while robbery was limited to a single incident in October. No homicides were reported during the quarter.

Overall, crime levels decreased across nearly all categories by December 2025, reflecting improved conditions and effective enforcement and prevention efforts as the year concluded.

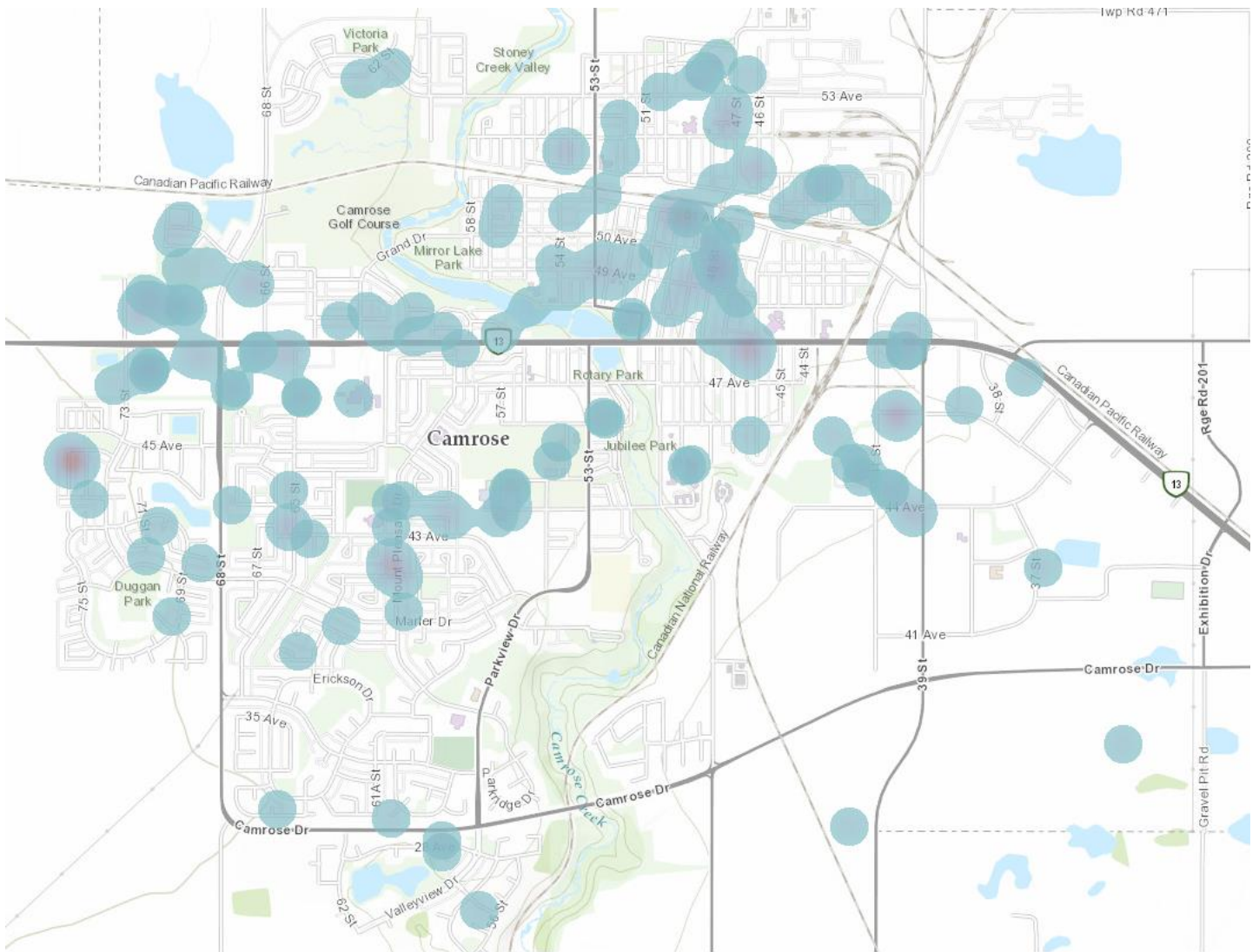
# December 2025 Eight Crime Indicators Map



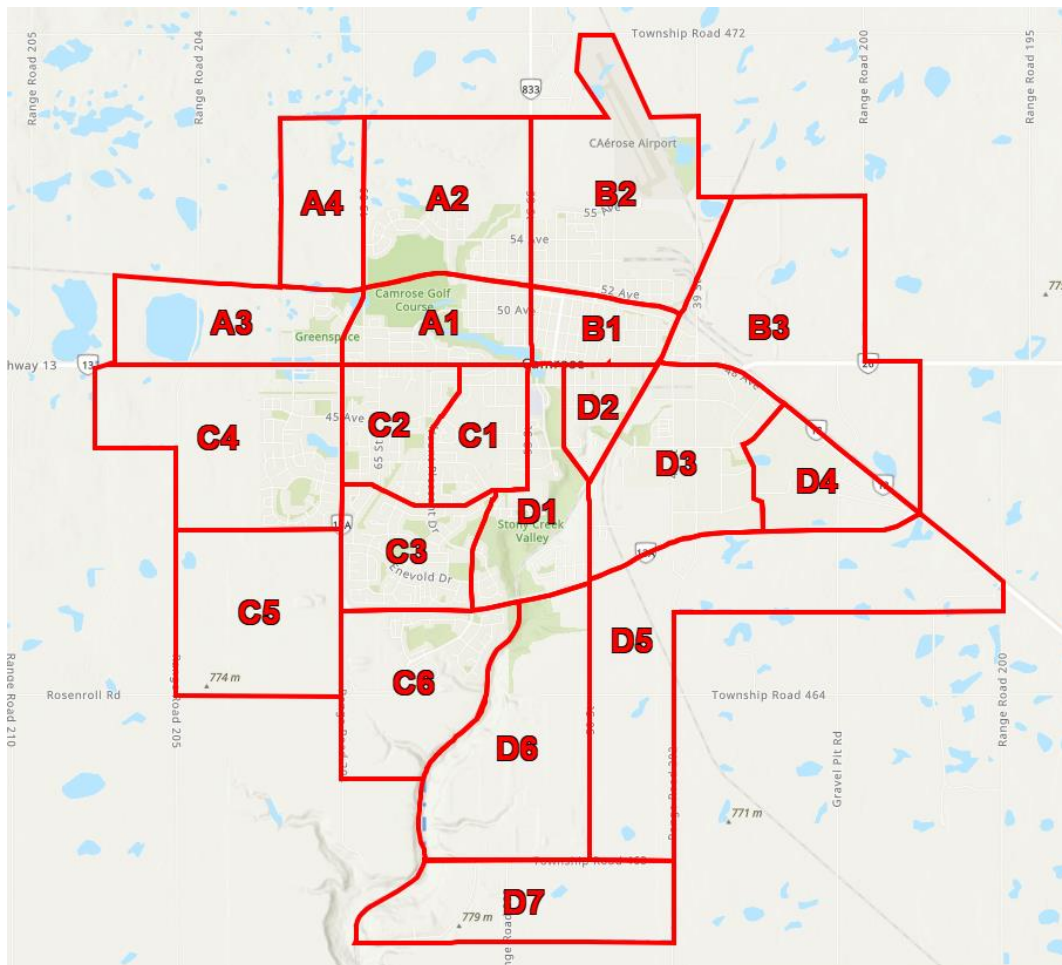
# Eight Crime Indicators Heat Map – December 2025



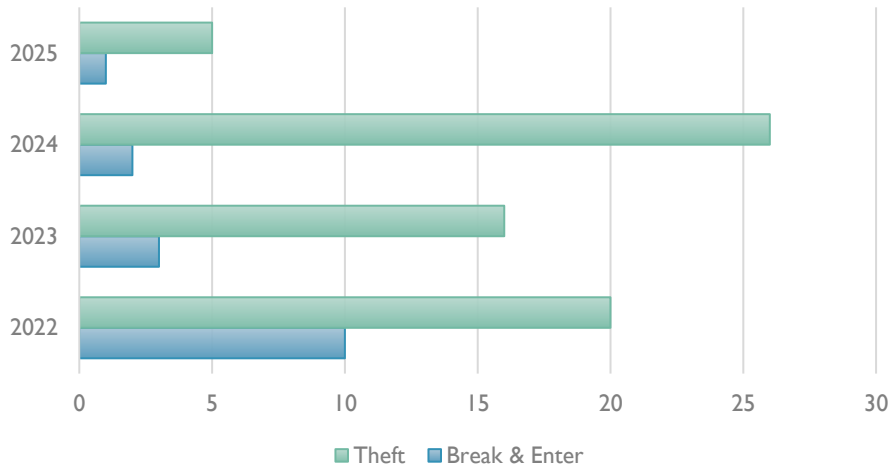
# Eight Crime Indicators Heat Map for 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter October - December, 2025



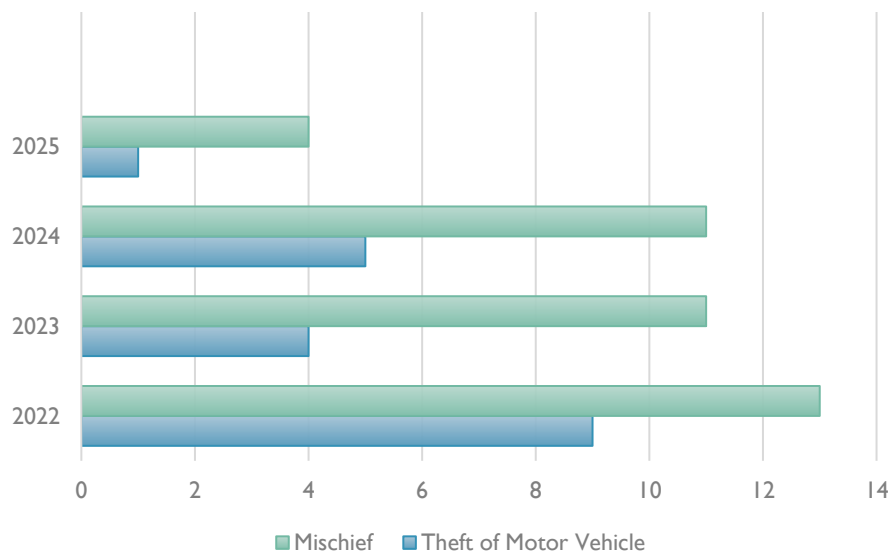
# Occurrence Zones Break & Enter and Thefts December 2025

## “Mandatory Alcohol Screening” (MAS) Statistics

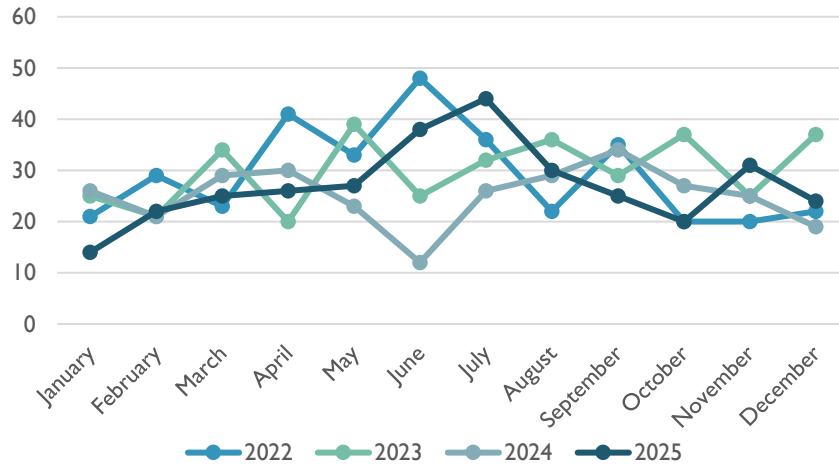
In December 2025, a total of 245 Mandatory Alcohol Screening (MAS) tests were administered, resulting in 6 charges being laid under the Intermediate Roadside Suspensions (IRS) program. There were no charges related to the Alberta Zero Alcohol Tolerance (AZAT) for graduate drivers, or 24-hour suspensions issued. There were also no impaired by alcohol or drug occurrences during the month.

# Crimes Against Persons

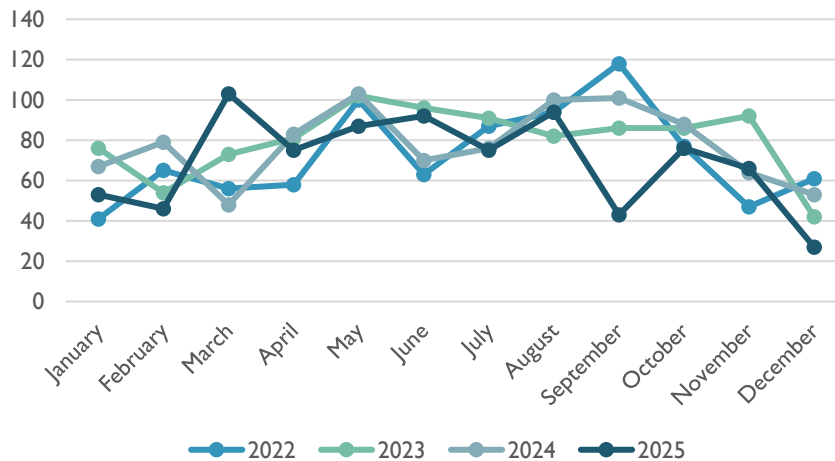
5 Year Monthly Average – 23

# Crimes Against Property

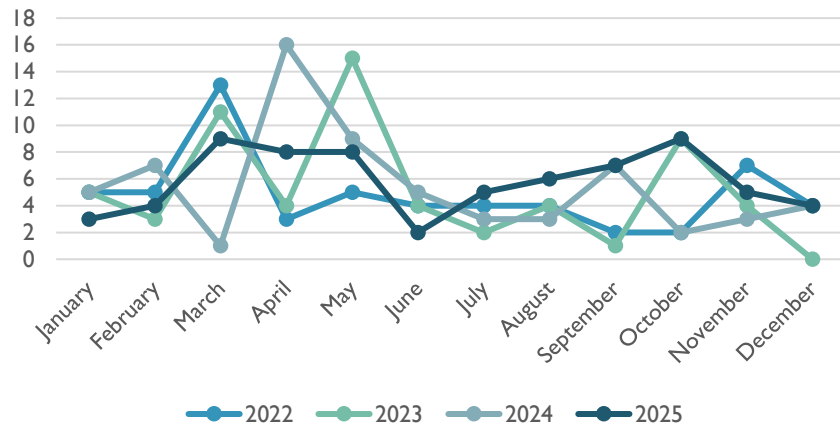
5 Year Monthly Average – 44

# Drug Occurrences

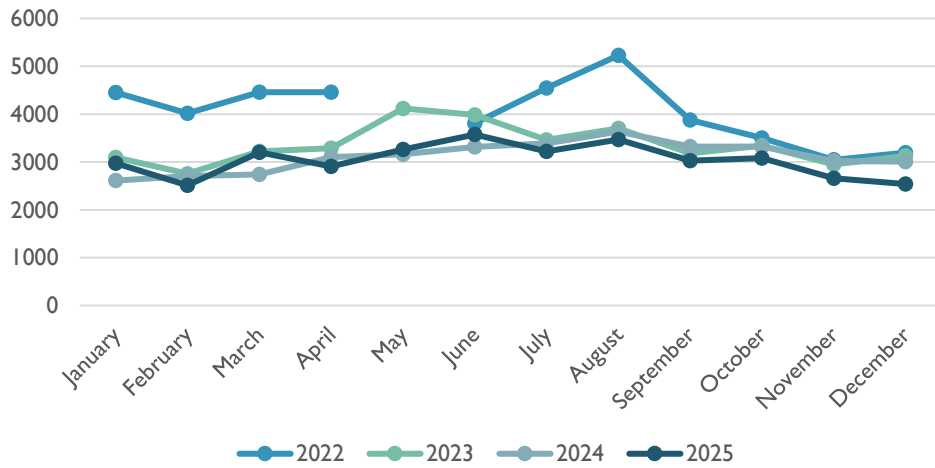
## 5 Year Monthly Average – 4

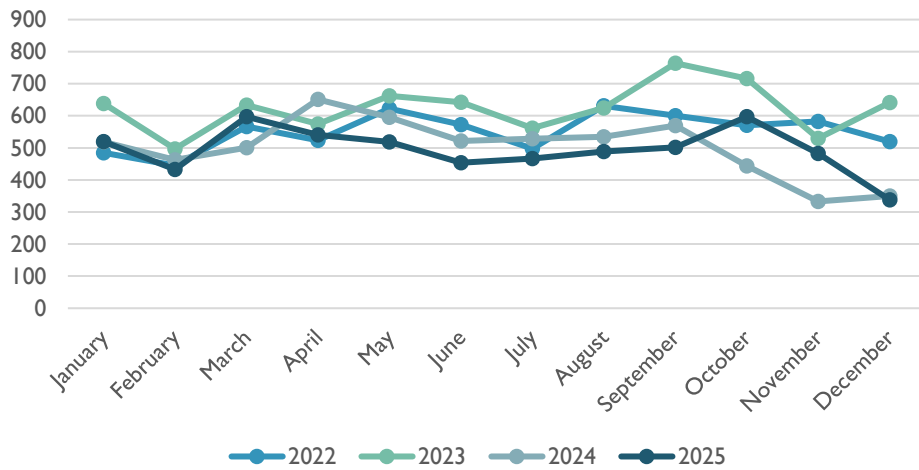

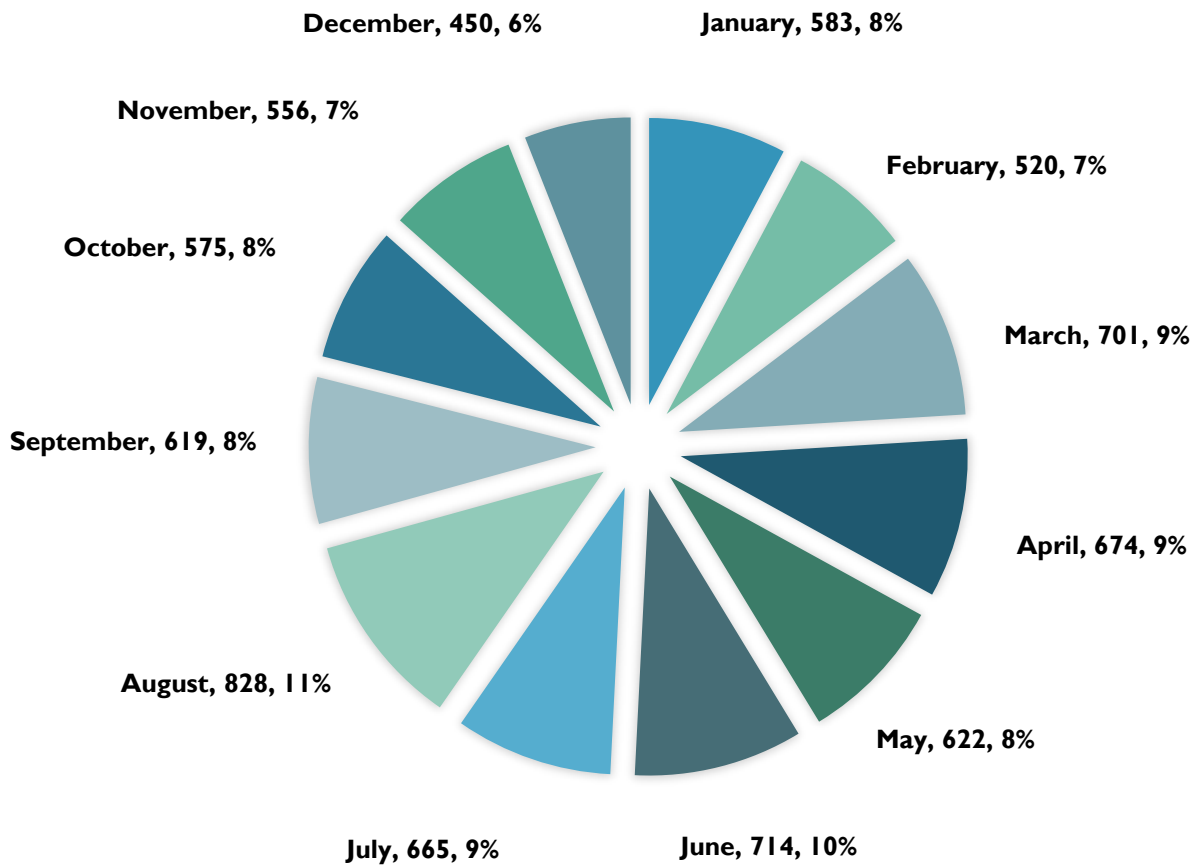

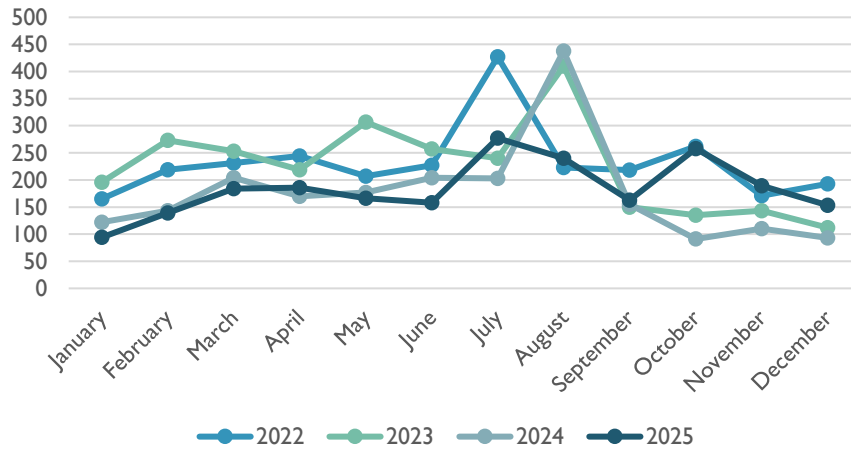

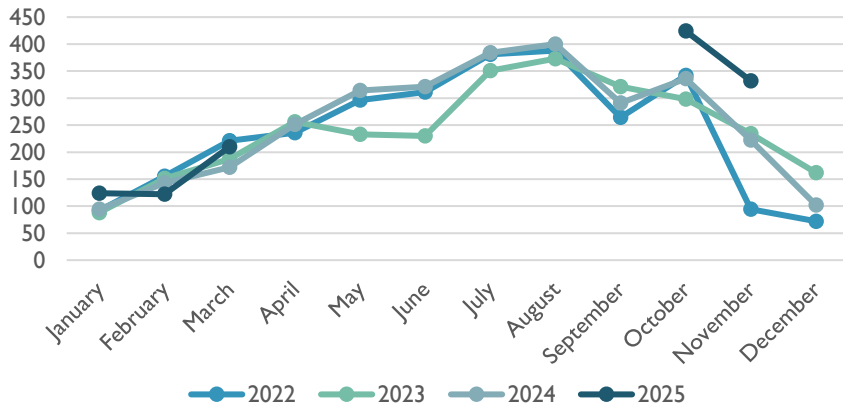
